1823 Pond on Police station site drained via creek at the back of Palmerston Road 89

Baffins Pond, Tangier Road

Note William Baffin 1584-1622 went to India for the East India Company.
Note Catherine de Braganza connected with Tangier and the East India Company, possible source

1784 Barvam Lake? 42
1833

Natural pond, sold to Corporation in 1934 for £5,500
Fed from a stream in Hayling Avenue, drains into Great Salterns Lake, originally via streams and Little Salterns Lake now culverted

1908 New iron pipe to be laid from corner of Baffins Pond close to Tangier Road to stream at Great Salterns, six feet deep 95

1969 More islands constructed for nesting 9

1993 Well drilled to find new spring to feed pond

2009 Part in-filled to create wet-lands on east side

Feb-May 2012 Quarter of pond in-filled to make wet-lands on west side
