



ORDER OF THE HEALTH OFFICER OF THE COUNTY OF SACRAMENTO DIRECTING ALL INDIVIDUALS LIVING IN THE COUNTY TO CONTINUE TO STAY AT HOME OR AT THEIR PLACE OF RESIDENCE AND RELAXING RESTRICTIONS ON LOW-RISK BUSINESSES CONSISTENT WITH DIRECTION FROM THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA DATE OF ORDER: June 12, 2020 UNDER THE AUTHORITY OF CALIFORNIA HEALTH AND SAFETY CODE SECTIONS 101040, 101085, AND 120175, THE HEALTH OFFICER OF THE COUNTY OF SACRAMENTO ("HEALTH OFFICER") ORDERS:

Effective at 11:59 p.m. on Friday June 12, 2020 and remains in place until it is rescinded or replaced by a future order.

How this affects the parks and facilities of the Arcade Creek Recreation and Park District:

Social Distancing and Face Coverings:

All persons are required to maintain Social Distancing requirements of six feet (6') or more, practicing good hand hygiene, STAY AT HOME IF ILL, and the wearing of Facial coverings, especially if Social Distancing is not possible.

Face Coverings are any covering made of cloth, fabric, or other soft permeable material, without holes that cover the nose, mouth, and chin. Face Coverings should be comfortable to wear, so that the person may breathe comfortably through the nose, so that it does not need to be adjusted frequently, to avoid touching of the face.

Masks with one-way expiration valves do not meet the requirement because they can release droplets that may carry the infection.

Masks are a way to protect those around you.

Masks should be worn both indoors and outdoors, especially if Social Distancing standards cannot be met, this is not required among members of the same household. Each person is asked to maintain a minimum of six (6) feet of spacing between themselves and other persons.

How this effects Arcade Creek Recreation and Park District and all other Park agencies in Sacramento County.

1. Indoor activities are not permitted.
2. Contact sports (basketball, football, soccer, baseball/softball, and other team activities) are not allowed.
3. Athletic training sessions where Social Distancing can be practiced are allowed.
4. Swimming Pools are permitted to open with crowd size and Social Distancing limitations.
5. Child-care/Day camps can begin.
6. Playgrounds remain closed.
7. Group picnics and gatherings are not allowed.
8. Same household/family picnics may happen at a single picnic table with less than ten (10) people.
9. Outdoor Activities where Social Distancing, and Face Masks are required for groups of 10 or less including the instructor(s) may be permitted on an Agency by Agency basis.
10. Park restrooms may open, if they can be kept well stocked, provide soap and/or hand-sanitizer, running water, and have regular cleaning times posted. (Some agencies may not be able to meet these requirements.
11. **WALKING, RUNNING, JOGGING, BIKE RIDING, OR ENJOYING TIME TO YOURSELF IN A PARK SETTING ARE PERMITTED AND ENCOURAGED. PLEASE STAY SAFE AND HEALTHY.**

PARK HOURS ARE 7:00 a.m. until DARK EACH DAY.

HAVE A GOOD DAY, ENJOY PART OF IT IN A PARK.
