

## **Arena Policies**

Municipal Council and Township Employees strive to provide our patrons with a safe, comfortable and enjoyable atmosphere for everyone. Patrons interfering with other patrons' ability to enjoy an event, including using foul or abusive language or inappropriate gestures, may be subject to eviction and turned over to the authorities. Patrons appearing to be under the influence of an illegal substance may also be evicted and turned over to the authorities.

- Alcoholic beverages may not be brought into the arena unless for a special event for which there is a liquor license and appropriate insurance.
- Smoking is permitted in a designated smoking area in the parking lot. Smoking materials must be extinguished 25 feet from the entrances.
- There are to be no cameras or recording devices of any kind permitted in the dressing rooms or washrooms.
- Fighting will not be tolerated.
- Hockey and other sports must be played on the designated playing surface only.
- No one, without special permission, is allowed on the ice surface while the zamboni doors are open or while the zamboni is on the ice.
- Spectators, as well as players, are not permitted to throw anything onto the ice surface at any time.
- Only authorized groups will be allowed dressing room access. Any individual who is not associated with a particular group and is found in a dressing room will be viewed as a trespasser and treated as such.
- Authorized groups must vacate their dressing rooms within 30 minutes of the completion of their activity.
- Animals that are not service animals are prohibited at the arena.
- For your own safety, we recommend that spectators monitor the puck during hockey games/practices at all times.
- While on the ice, there is to be no gum chewing, eating or drinking. (Exception: Water may be consumed on or at benches)
- No one under the age of twelve is allowed in the arena without being directly supervised by an adult.
- There is a maximum of two people allowed in the time keeper's box at any time.
- Foreign objects are not allowed on the ice surface at any time.
