

October PTO Meeting Recap

These are not meant to be official meeting minutes, just meeting highlights

- There are multiple positions still open this year. If you are interested or would like to learn more contact us at wallaceptopres@yahoo.com for more information.
- We need a theme day chairperson! The theme is Science this year. We are looking at early February for the date.
- We are in need of a bylaw update. A committee will start work this month. If you are interested contact Jackie Johnson.
- Spring Read-A-Thon proceeds from last year will be used to purchase 5 or 6 Mimeos for Wallace. The remainder will be used to help fund Raz Kids purchase for all K-2 classrooms in the building.
- FAST Assessment details presented by Mrs. Pearson. These are reading only screenings that are done for K-3 grades. They will be assessed 3 times yearly. Student nonproficient in the standards will get intervention, including weekly progress monitoring. Wallace had a relatively low number of nonproficient students in the first round of screening. Nonproficiency will be addressed at fall conferences.
- Grant requests were reviewed and voted on. Total requested grant funds were less than the budget of \$3,000. All grants but 1,2 and 10 were fully funded. Raz Kids will be purchased for all classrooms in K-2 instead. We will look at feasibility of funding request # 10 for all students or not at all.
