ORDINANCE NO. DECEMBER 14, 1983

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MILLCREEK, LEBANON COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, PROHIBITING THE PARKING OF VEHICLES ON, UPON, OR ALONG BOTH SIDES OF EAST ALUMNI AVENUE IN THE VILLAGE OF NEWMANSTOWN.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Millcreek, County of Lebanon, and Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of the same, that henceforth the parking of vehicles on, upon, or along both sides of East Alumni Avenue in the Village of Newmanstown, from a point of beginning at Ash Road to a point of ending at North Sheridan Road, is prohibited at all times. The word "vehicle" as used herein shall have the same meaning as it has in the Pennsylvania Vehicle Code. "No Parking" signs shall be erected in accordance with the law throughout said area. Any person who violates this ordinance shall pay a fine of five (5.00) Dollars for each offense. Each continuation of a violation beyond twelve hours shall be deemed and shall be taken to be a separate offense and shall be punishable as such.
