Kennel cough—Add \$14.00

Kennel cough—Only \$26.50



2021 Dog tags and Kennel License may be purchased until March 31st with fees as follows:

\$ 2.00 Spayed/neutered

\$ 4.00 Unaltered pets

\$10.00 Kennel License (3+ dogs)

As of April 1st unpaid tags/licenses will be assessed penalties, increasing fees to:

\$ 7.00 Spayed/neutered

\$ 9.00 Unaltered pets

\$40.00 Kennel License (3+ dogs)

City Wide Clean Up

Please separate wood and metal items and place near the roadway for easy access. Break or cut wood and brush items into 4’ lengths and bundle together near the roadway. Alternative Location: For your convenience, a roll-off dumpster will be located at the City Park from May 21st through June 1st should you wish to dispose of items immediately.

The following items will be collected:

- Boxes
- Scrap Metal
- Furniture
- Carpeting
- Logs, branches, tree trimmings

These items will not be collected:

- Tires
- Batteries
- Motor Oil
- Dead Animals
- Household hazardous materials
- Appliances with Freon

10 BEST WAYS TO REDUCE YOUR POWER BILL

- 1.) **LEAVE THE THERMOSTAT ON ONE TEMPERATURE**— *Set the thermostat to one temp and leave it there*
- 2.) **UNPLUG IT**— *If you're not using it, unplug it*
- 3.) **SWITCH TO LED LIGHTS**— *Change your incandescent bulbs to LED lights*
- 4.) **USE THE OVEN LESS**— *Grill more often or batch cook*
- 5.) **LET CLOTHING AIR DRY**— *Let your clothing air dry outside or on a drying rack*
- 6.) **REDUCE HOT WATER HEATER TEMPERATURE**— *Reduce hot water heater temp or invest in a more energy efficient hot water heater*
- 7.) **TURN OFF THE LIGHTS**— *Turn off the lights when you leave a room or use the only at night*
- 8.) **IMPROVE INSULATION**— *Improve the insulation to make it easier for your home to maintain a consistent temperature*
- 9.) **CLOSE BLINDS OR CURTAINS**— *Close blinds or curtains to reflect sunlight and help your home stay cooler*
- 10.) **WASH DISHES BY HAND**— *Skip the dishwasher and wash dishes by hand when you can*



Don't forget if you are wanting to burn in the city limits you need to call or stop by Moran City Hall Monday— Friday 8:00am to 5:00pm to obtain a burn permit. The permits are free of charge but they help us to know who is burning in our area. If you have a fire pit we still ask that you call and check with our office due to possible Red Flag/Burn Ban Policies. If you are outside the city limits you need to call Allen County Dispatch at 620-365-1437 and report your controlled burn.

Sewer Rates

Don't forget that your new sewer rates are reflected on your March 10, 2021 utility bill. These rates are based on your household water usage from December, January and February. DISCONNECT, RECONNECT CHARGES.

If a utility bill has not been paid on or before the due date as provided in this chapter, a penalty for non-payment shall be assessed as stated on the utility bill. The amount due, plus penalty shall be due by the 30th of each month, except for February when the amount shall be due by the last day of the month, unless the due date falls on a Saturday, Sunday or legal holiday, in which event the customer has until the close of the next business day in which to pay the charges.
