- 3. No self propelled or radio-controlled models will be allowed to be entered.
- Junior division is limited to modelers who have not reached their 18th birthday as of 17 April 2022. Modelers qualifying as Junior may enter any other category, however, they may not enter more than one category with any model. Categories for Juniors will be split as follows: Juniors 12 and under and Juniors 13 and over. Juniors will be eligible to win specialty awards.
- 5. Contest judges are not permitted to judge a category in which they are entered.
