

The regular meeting of the Sherman Township Board was held on December 6th, 2017 at 7:00pm at the township hall. Meeting called to order by Supervisor. After the pledge of allegiance, roll call taken: members present: D Berens, K Berens, Miller, K Smalligan, Stocking. Absent: None. There was a motion by Stocking, 2nd by D Berens to approve the agenda with removal of county treasurer comments. All yes, agenda approved.

There was a motion by K Berens, 2nd by K Smalligan, to approve the minutes of the November 6th, 2017 regular meeting. All yes, minutes of Nov 6th, meeting approved.

There was no public comment at this time.

Berens gave the treasurer's report including bills to be paid. There was motion by Stocking, 2nd by D Berens to accept the report and approve the bills. Roll call vote; YES: D Berens, K Berens, Miller, K Smalligan, Stocking. NO, none. Absent: None. Motion passed.

Clerk said that he had received no correspondence for the last month.

Miller said that he and Lee Hoppa would meet with the road commission about dead trees on the road commission property at Crystal Lake. He said that we still have not received any money for the tire removal.

There was nothing from the trustees at this time.

K Berens said she had billed for 2 Fremont fire runs and had not collected anything last month.

Doug Berens said that the PZC is working on some language cleanup.

The building inspector gave his report including issuing 6 permits, 3 for Camp Echo.

Chad Kukal gave the zoning administrator report and said he is working on the fire hydrant at Robinson Lake.

Karen Korpoces said that the sewer authority had gotten 5 bids for the up-grade of the pump stations.

Assessor Stroven said that Paulsen had not yet come out to look at the furnace. He said that some of the problem might be with how the renters set the thermostat. He is going to work with Karl DeVisser to show the renters how to set the thermostat.

He said that he had changed the flag on October 12th and that it had been up for 6 months.

The December board of review will be on the 12th at 8:30am.

There is a hearing of the tax tribunal in February. He is working on getting a title for a double wide home so it can be sold.

The property that had been on the delapidated list has been settled.

Karl DeVisser was not at the meeting but had ask the board to consider putting a dumpster in the cemetery or in back of the hall. Miller to put this on the agenda for a future meeting.

The White Cloud fire department is still working on getting a light at M-37 the new fire truck has been ordered with delivery in June of 2018. Chief Cruzan is working on getting a sign in front of the building. There was nothing new from the Fremont fire dept.

There was no unfinished or new business that had not been covered.

Under public comment Karen Korpoces thanked Chad Kukal for taking care of a complaint quickly.

Stan Stroven asked the township board to approve paying for Board of Review training for members. There was a motion by K Berens, 2nd by K Smalligan to pay for the training for any Board of Review member that wants to attend. Roll call vote; YES: D Berens, K Berens, Miller, K Smalligan, Stocking. NO, none. Absent: None. Motion passed. Stroven also asked who should be considered the 1st alternate and 2nd alternate for the Board of Review. Clerk said that Wolffis was sworn in before Chenard if that made a difference.

Under township board member comments, Miller wished everyone a Merry Christmas.
