OUR COMMITMENT to you and the parameters we have in place, are all efforts to REMAIN OPEN, and ensure a HEALTHY environment for all who enter. We are doing the best we can, with the staffing we have available, to accommodate your rental.

What to expect this month...

PRIOR TO ARRIVAL

1. Come dressed with minimal need for change. **Please let your group know ahead of time to come dressed.** Goalies will be allotted a larger area for gear rinkside. **NO LOCKER ROOMS will be available for the month of OCTOBER.** If a participant needs a private space to change, ONE set of bathrooms inside the rink will be available for 10 minutes prior to ice time and 10 minutes after ice time.

2. Sign in roster must be completed ***PRIOR TO ENTRY***. The names on the roster upon entry, are the names that will remain in the facility for the duration of the hourly rental.

UPON ENTRY

1. Doors will open TEN MINUTES PRIOR to your ice rental. Do not show up earlier. It may be cold, it may be raining. Doors open 10 minutes prior. Please stay warm, safe and in the car until then. (If your ice time is at 9:30....Doors will open for entry at 9:20)

2. Give Rink Attendant your roster with all participants and coaches listed.

3. Participants MUST arrive on time. Rink Attendants will not wait at the door for late arrivals. If you know you are going to be late, let your coach know, so they can communicate that to the staff and staff can check back for late comers, 10 minutes in. They cannot stand at the door, while their attention is needed in the rink.

4. MASK UP! All who enter the main entrance **MUST** either be wearing a mask or a helmet with a face shield. One or the other **MUST** remain on, while in the facility at all times.

5. NO SPECTATORS. Parent “coaches” on the list of 25 or less, (as designated by the Rental Contact) can sit in the player boxes, or on the X’s in the front row of the bleachers. These coaches are not determined by our staff, but predetermined, by the Rental Contact, whose name is on the rink agreement upon ice reservations. Again...**25 or LESS.** No spectating from the bleachers or warming room at all.

ONCE INSIDE

1. . FOLLOW the X’s -The state requires us to ensure that all participants remain a safe distance apart while in the facility. There are 25 designated spots (X’s), 6 feet apart, painted on the bottom row of the bleachers along the front side of the rink. They stretch from the warming room all the way down to the restrooms on the east end of the rink. Each participant enters, goes all the way down to find the furthest X, sets down their belongings, water bottle, slides, etc.

2. ICE TIME - if your group is on time, dressed and ready, you may be able to jump on the ice sooner if Ice is ready. **PLEASE remember, each ice slot is 50 minutes (unless more time was rented). If you use any equipment on the ice for training or drills.... You must use the last couple minutes of your slot to clear the ice of pucks, training equipment etc., so the ice cut can stay on schedule.**

AFTER YOUR RENTAL

1. 10 MINUTES to remove skates, use the restroom if necessary, gather belongings and exit the facility.

2. EXIT - all skaters and coaches. Please exit out the corner door closest to the community center entrance.
