

## Conference Workshop Overview:

### Day 1: Sounds Like Fun!! Play Therapy Strategies for Tweens and Teens

In this exciting (and probably loud) workshop, the participants will get to experience a wide variety of fun play therapy activities that they can use with their preteen and teen clients. The focus will be on new and creative strategies that play therapists can use to "hook" pre-adolescents and adolescents into engaging fully in the therapeutic process. Through these playful interventions, clients can gain a sense of belonging, develop positive identities, increase self-esteem, build meaningful relationships, gain personal power in positive ways, and practice appropriate expression of feelings.

### Day 2: The Creative Play Therapist – Cultivating Your Creativity for Enhanced Effectiveness

Creativity is a cornerstone of effective counseling (Gladding, 2008), which can be bad news for those of us who are not "naturally creative" or who go through "creative droughts" in our work. In this experiential workshop, participants will learn and practice ways to cultivate creativity in their play therapy practices, even when they don't feel creative. Special emphasis will be placed on developing and facilitating creativity in designing, selecting, sequencing, and practicing play therapy techniques.

## Ethics Workshop Overview:

### Supporting Family Bonds while Protecting Privacy of the Tween/Teen in Play Therapy Implementation

This workshop will explore primary ethical issues for practitioners as relating to working with tween/teen clients and their caregivers in play therapy. We will also look at how to explain confidentiality and privacy in play therapy as it applies to use of expressive modalities.
