- Janice secured a block of rooms for the show at Super 8 (x10 @\$86/night) & Coshocton Inn/Suites (x5 @\$107/night) but will be calling to increase that to 15 & 10, respectively
- Jean mentioned that Roscoe Cabins available to rent nearby – have full kitchens inside
- We will not accept any “pending” ILR registrations – they must have an ILR # to enter
- We discussed some show entry form price/logistic changes & Char will work on this
- Stalls will be assigned on “first come first served” basis & there is a limited # available
- Char will send a judging contract to Cathie Kindler – she will be the “Daffodil Judge”
- Mike Haumschild is confirmed and he will be the “ORVLA Judge”
- Non Breeder classes will be split into “7 & under” and “8 & over” categories
- Entry deadline will be April 15, 2023!
- Kris found a beautiful gift for Best of Show & Bev will look into engraving these
- We discussed Grand/Reserve prizes & may go with ribbons this year
- We discussed a possible farm gift of a clipboard with a llama health info decal on it (heartrate, temp, respiratory rate, etc) & an ORVLA pen
- Janice will order ORVLA pens
- Haumschild’s 4-H club will be doing the obstacles & we voted to pay them at least \$300
- Janice will be superintendent
