Check Your Ego at the Door

Some of you may remember Quincy Jones who is a performer, entertainer, composer, promoter, producer, director and arranger. Quincy has an amazing ability to bring superstars from the entertainment industry together. He has brought some of the most highly acclaimed names of the music industry together at various times throughout the years. He is noted for giving stars a single line, a phrase here and there, and being able to combine their skills in a very moving expression of music.

Jones is best known for his production several years ago titled "We are the World," which featured the combined talents of many of the top pop singers of the day. It really is amazing that he brought together that many superstars with super-egos and pulled it off. He pulled together an amazing team of superstars and created something wonderful. The main way that he accomplished this feat was by putting a sign over the entry to the recording studio: CHECK YOUR EGO AT THE DOOR! That single reminder kept everyone humble throughout the recording experience.

Isn't that a great phrase for Christians to remember as we do the work of Christ on the earth? With every endeavor, every breath, every action we take, we need to "check our ego at the door." 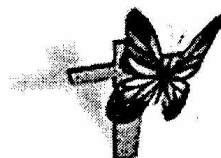
