PRESIDENT'S LETTER

I hope all of you had a safe and happy holiday season to end 1985. I'm sure each and every one of us is ready to begin the second half of the season. During the first half, a few minor problems have occurred and hopefully these can be corrected so as not to interfere with your play during the third and fourth quarters.

The first item is this newsletter. When the newsletter was started some years ago the D.D.A. began the season approximately the third week of October. With the need of longer scheduling to accommodate a much larger league came an earlier starting date, so that the season could be finished by the May 30th deadline regulated by by-laws which are still in effect today. The newsletter dates were never changed, to accommodate the earlier starting times.

It was time to rearrange our release dates on a better time schedule to better serve the darters of the D.D.A. and our advertisers.

The new dates are Sept. (right before the start of league play, to cover any last minute rule changes.) Nov., Jan., Mar., May., (to cover last minute details of our yearly banquet) and July. Applications will be in the last newsletter so you will have about 7 weeks to get your team together for the next season.

I feel that the inconvenience will not outweigh the benefits of this move.

It seems a misunderstanding took place at the Board of Directors meeting at the start of the season. Subs are not allowed! Subs were permitted during the summer due to it being the vacation period and the possibility of two players being out of town at the same time. Subs were discussed but a vote was

not taken to allow them during the regular season. Being as this was a misunderstanding and that subs were used on several teams the Board decided to waive the rule until Jan. 1, 1986. Any who uses a player not according to league rules, will forfeit that match per the rules.

Also a team may not borrow a player from another team for any reason.

The posting of scores will not be delayed due to phone calls or scorecards not being received. Penalty points will be deducted immediately and standing sheets will be printed and released at the first of the following week of play.

When scorecards are received the point totals will be corrected at the next posting of scores.

On several occasions unsportsmanship behavior has been reported by members. These displays are uncalled for as they harm the reputation of our association and will not be tolerated any longer.

On a good note, I would like to congratulate ED CONDUFF for his hard work in assembling the Quad City Challenge Team. Due to the untiring efforts of Ed, the team, as a whole, played well and a good time was had by all. Once again, thanks Ed.

The Board's meeting schedule is contained in this issue and any member is invited to attend and point out any problems they feel need to be addressed.

Finally the Summer League plaques have been received. I am sorry for the delay.


