KYLLONEN IS NEWEST GISBT CHAMPION URBEN PICKS UP TOUR WIN # 2

KYLLONEN BECOMES 120th BOYS CHAMPION

Ryan Kyllonen added his name to the illustrious list of GISBT champions at this month's event. The talented 2-hander from Bethel, Minnesota stamped his name on the championship hardware with some steady shooting throughout the day. However, he used an impressive 289 in the penultimate game to secure an insurmountable 181-pin lead heading into the position round, where his 176 failed to matter in the final outcome; his final margin of victory was an even 100 pins.

The champ made his debut on tour back at the season opener in Cedar Rapids, and immediately gave notice of his arrival as a force by finishing 6th. This month, in only his 3rd tour start, he raised the bar even higher.

Kyllonen became the GISBT's 120th different champion in the boy's division since the tour began in August 1992. He also became the 9th 2-handed champion in tour history. Brian Valenta was the tour's first 2-handed winner, claiming 4 titles between November 2000 and February 2003. He was followed by Tony Handrahan, Spencer Werthmann, Josh Powell, Dakota Solonka, Caleb Miller, Sean Martin II, Seth Sikkema and now Kyllonen.

The champion averaged 229.81 for his 16 games. He took home a \$325 scholarship, the championship plaque, and earns a permanent place on Champions Row. Congratulations, Ryan!

WOLF'S RUNNER-UP FINISH IS BEST OF CAREER

Avery Wolf continued his great season at this month's tour stop by recording the highest finish of his GISBT career. Coming into the event, his best showing was a 3rd place finish at last September's tour stop in Waterloo. This time out, the southpaw from Skokie, Illinois earned a runner-up finish, and the accompanying \$200 scholarship.

Wolf barely slid into the match play finals – the 4th of his career – earning the final bid by just 3 sticks. Once there, however, he was razor sharp, gradually moving up the standings. He caught fire over the final 2 games, firing 279 and 269 to surge into the runner-up spot.

HIBBARD EARNS 3rd, PUSHES PAST \$4,000 IN CAREER TOUR EARNINGS

Billy Hibbard's GISBT career is winding down, but he's showing no signs of slowing down. The talented stroker from Mukwonago, Wisconsin tossed in another fine performance at this month's tour stop in Muscatine by finishing 3rd; he took home a \$175 scholarship for his finish. The payday helped boost Hibbard's tour haul past the \$4,000 mark; in 29 events over the past 4 seasons, he's earned \$4,170. This month also marked the 19th match play finals appearance of Hibbard's tour career.

DENTON OPENS WITH 300, TAKES 4th IN FINALS RETURN

Zack Denton returned to the match play finals for the 2nd time in his career, but this was his first finals appearance since December 2016. The right-hander from Waverly, lowa got his day started off with perfection, as he authored a 300 game in his very first game of qualifying. From there, his consistency paid off with a 4th place finish – his highest ever in 55 tour starts. He earned a \$150 scholarship for his efforts.

MINER FINISHES 5th

Jayson Miner set a fast pace in qualifying by averaging 232.50 for his first 8 games, and the resulting +260 total was enough to earn him this month's High Qualifier medal. During match play, he slipped into 5th place, adding a \$130 scholarship to his account. This was the 8th match play finals appearance for the Silvis, Illinois resident.

TACORDA TAKES 6th

Andre Tacorda, a promising 2-hander from Roseville, California, was this month's 6th place finisher. Tacorda got his qualifying block jump-started with a 300 game to allow him to surge into the match play finals with momentum – the first finals of his career. He took home a \$120 scholarship for his efforts. Tacorda is one of the tour's players garnering a lot of attention for future success.

JONES PLACES 7th

William Jones returned to the finals for the 3rd time in his 5 tour appearances. This time out, the stroker from Anoka, Minnesota finished 7th, capturing a \$110 payday for his performance.

ZILK ROUNDS OUT FINALS WITH 8th PLACE SHOWING

Josh Zilk, a Virginia Beach, Virginia native, rounded out this month's boy's finals field by finishing 8th. The versatile right-hander earned a \$100 scholarship for his day's work.

Stan Sikkema, from Fulton, Illinois took home a \$55 scholarship by having this month's high game out of the money – a stellar 268 in his qualifying round.

The Tournament of Champions is always a spectacle, with the introduction of all 36 competitors, the distribution of all year-end GISBT awards, a special tribute to departing members, and a prize fund of nearly \$5,000 with all 36 bowlers guaranteed a share of. This year's Tournament of Champions takes place Sunday, May 10 at Leisure Lanes in Davenport, Iowa.

URBEN PICKS UP 2nd CAREER WIN

URBEN POSTS UNDEFEATED RECORDS, CLAIMS 2nd TOUR TITLE

Sydney Urben became a 2-time tour champion at this month's event; the Door, Michigan native also won the season opener in Cedar Rapids. She used shot-making and consistency to record the win, and as a result, she took home a \$250 scholarship. The 19 year-old qualified 3rd, but she averaged 220.33 for the finals, and that enabled her to slowly build a lead, and in the end, her winning margin was 123 pins.

CHAMP GOES UNDEFEATED IN MATCH PLAY

Once match play began, Urben was unstoppable, as the smooth-rolling right-hander rolled to an unblemished match play record by winning all 6 of her matches.

This month's champion averaged 212.28 for her 14 games. Along with the \$250 scholarship, she also received the championship plaque. Congratulations, Sydney!

MADISON IN CAREER FORM, EARNS RUNNER-UP FINISH

Brynna Madison enjoyed a breakthrough performance at this month's tour stop. The slender right-hander from Lincoln, Nebraska bowled exceptional all day, and it led to a runner-up showing. The 18 year-old set the pace in qualifying by averaging 215.75 for her 8 games, and that enabled her to earn the High Qualifier medal and tote a 31-pin lead heading into the match play finals – the first of her promising career.

IN CAREER FINALS # 20, COUREY CLAIMS 3rd

Cassidy Courey rolled into the 20th match play finals of her stellar tour career at this month's event. The 3-time winner from Brooklyn Center, Minnesota took home a \$150 scholarship by virtue of her 3rd place showing.

In the 28 season history of the GISBT, only 14 girls have qualified for more than 20 match play finals, with the all-time record being a seemingly unbreakable record held by Emily Papke, of Davenport, Iowa, who qualified for 50 match play finals during her career (2000-2008).

2-TIME CHAMP NELSON FINISHES 4th

Addy Nelson continues to pad her Bowler of the Year points lead. At this month's event, she was in fine form again, and it led to a 4th place finish, and an accompanying \$120 scholarship. In her rookie season on tour, Nelson has earned 2 titles, and has qualified for the match play finals in all 5 events. She currently enjoys a 134 point lead in this season's Bowler of the Year race.

WILLIAMS 5th IN MATCH PLAY DEBUT

Jenna Williams was this month's 5th place finisher. The 19 year-old from Homosassa, Florida earned a \$110 paycheck for her day's work. Williams rolls one of the biggest strike balls on tour, and appears headed for great things to come as her career continues to blossom.

LAKE PLACES 6th

Alexis Lake completed the girl's match play finals field; the Kaysville, Utah resident took home a \$100 scholarship. Lake, 19, was appearing in the 2nd match play finals of her GISBT career.

The high game out of the money was awarded to Hannah Jaros, from Yorkville, Illinois. The 20 year-old was making her tour debut at this month's event, and her 258 game enabled her to earn a \$55 scholarship by having the high game out of the money.
