You may claim the remaining money at any time within one year after the county receives the money. OR
2.Because you were a commercial tenant and this property is believed to be worth less than the lesser of \$750, or \$1 per square foot of the premises you occupied, it may be kept, sold, or destroyed without further notice if you fail to reclaim it within the time indicated above.
