Statement on Voter ID Law

The Wanggaard campaign released the following statement after the Wisconsin Supreme Court announced the upholding of Wisconsin's Voter ID law.

“Voter ID is critical to ensuring integrity in our electoral process, and I was proud to co-author this legislation. Now that the State Supreme Court has found Voter ID constitutional, I am hopeful that the Federal Appeals Court will agree with what we already know – there is nothing wrong with requiring someone to show an ID before they vote.”

Van Wanggaard is running to retake the 21st State Senate district after he was recalled for standing with Governor Walker during the Act 10 battle. He now faces an August 12th primary election. He has been endorsed by Congressman Paul Ryan, Speaker Robin Vos, Representative Samantha Kerkman, Racine Tea Party PAC, and over 70 state and local leaders.
