

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### Cont'd -- A Note from the President....



## And Now A Word From Our Dockmaster . . .



This is the first time since I've been dockmaster that all ten boat slips have been rented out! The boat ramp, parking area and dock are a happening place!

With the increased usage, come a few reminders . . . please remember boat slips DO NOT come with docking lines. Every boat owner is responsible to furnish their own lines to tie up their boats to the slips. Unfortunately we've had at least two different slip owners have their lines stolen. They came in from a day on the water only to find they have no lines to tie up their boat. In one instance they found their lines was being used by the company Dockmasters to tie up

their pilings to the dock. If any of our property owners have Dockmasters or any dock company doing work on their docks, please let them know not to use the lines on the dock - and where to park. Many slip holders don't leave their boats in the slips all of the time but they do expect their lines to be there when they need them. If you are a slip holder, consider some sort of marking on your lines to identify them as yours. Also we've had instance of people walking on people's boats (dirty footprints were found on the seats where somebody has boarded a boat that wasn't theirs and walked around it). We have had crab pots emptied by someone other than the owner. Please remember, crab pots, ropes, and boats are private property. Please don't touch or take items that aren't yours at the dock.

Well it has been an active hurricane season and we've been really lucky so far! Hopefully we will make it through the season with nothing headed our way. As a reminder though, during named storms in our area for those renting a CBTB slip at the dock, you must remove your boat from the water. Also during named storms, as a safety precaution, property owners may park their boats in the parking lot at the clubhouse. (Please do not park on the grass.)

Speaking of parking . . . Despite the signs and many reminders, people are still parking in the turnaround area by the boat ramp. Hopefully the above graphic will help. Please park your vehicle as far to the right (near the woods) as possible. If you see some parking in the turn around area, ask them kindly to move their car. There is no overnight parking at the dock. Also, please lock the gate if you are going to be there for more than ten minutes. Please consider your neighbors when parking, using the dock and the boat launch. It belongs to all of us and we all need to be able to use it.

CBTB has acres of wooded lots and lots without homes in the community. Some lots belong to property owners while others belong to CBTB. Though our community is in a rural setting, we are still a community with more and more people moving in on a monthly basis. All good news! Just a few reminders though:

- Please do not dump your brush on empty lots. That land belongs to someone and if it is CBTB property we will need to pay to have it removed. Brush and yard debris can be taken to R.L. Self Timber at no cost to you. Self Timber is at 6088 Mary Ball Road in Lancaster and they are open 8:00-4:30 Monday thru Saturday and 12:00-4:00 on Sundays.
- Please don't let your pets run free, especially with hunting season just a round the corner. (As a reminder, hunting dogs are permitted in Lancaster Co. and occasionally you see them driving deer through the neighborhood and we'd hate for you to have your dog follow.)
- Please clean-up after your pets, especially if they 'go' in someone's front yard.
- Remind your contractors and guests the speed limit is 25 mph after Marina Drive. Recently there have been reports of contractors zipping around Corrotoman Drive circle. The circle is used for bike riding, walking, running and visiting neighbors. Share the road. Thanks for your consideration! We're all in this neighborhood together, so let's respect each other's property and our own common property.
