Credits:

Cross credit with some academic courses (including 4th year related math, VPAA, math & science) may be available and will be reviewed on a case-by-case basis with each district's counseling department.

Program Description

The Accounting program provides students with a basic knowledge of accounting and enables them to prepare and understand basic financial records for a service and merchandising business. Students will proceed through the entire accounting cycle from journalizing to closing the books. Microsoft Excel computer program will be used extensively in conjunction with the program when preparing financial documents and exploring the stock market and other investment strategies.

The advanced level will emphasize corporate transactions, detailed financial statements, and complex transactions. Virtual Business Online will be used as a hands-on simulation for making sound financial decisions for both business and personal finances.
