Supervision and guidance will be provided by two ideal leaders who are committed to launching this pilot project for Spring 2014.

- 4. Program will be supervised by a minimum of 2 adult NTWC staff.
- 5. Computers will be on hand for students to use for homework and games.
- 6. Homework help will be offered, as well as socializing and activities that promote communication, teamwork, awareness and fun.
- 7. Snacks will be available. (Please inform NTWC of any allergies.)
- 8. Students are responsible to sign in and out each day they attend.
- 9. Students are expected to be respectful toward other students, staff, and the space.
- 10. Students will clean up after themselves.
- 11. Fighting, bullying or foul language is not acceptable.
