


For the grace to keep our eyes focused on Christ and to follow him with a renewed commitment. **We pray.**



With the start of another school year just around the corner, it is also time to start planning our faith development year. Our faith development program is

Registrations for the biweekly sessions of faith development for St. Augustine's and St. Lawrence O'Toole will be taking place on Sunday, September 11th 12:00noon - 1:00pm in the church basement of St. Augustine's. Please use the door at the top of the stairs in the parking lot, proceeding downstairs to the basement.
