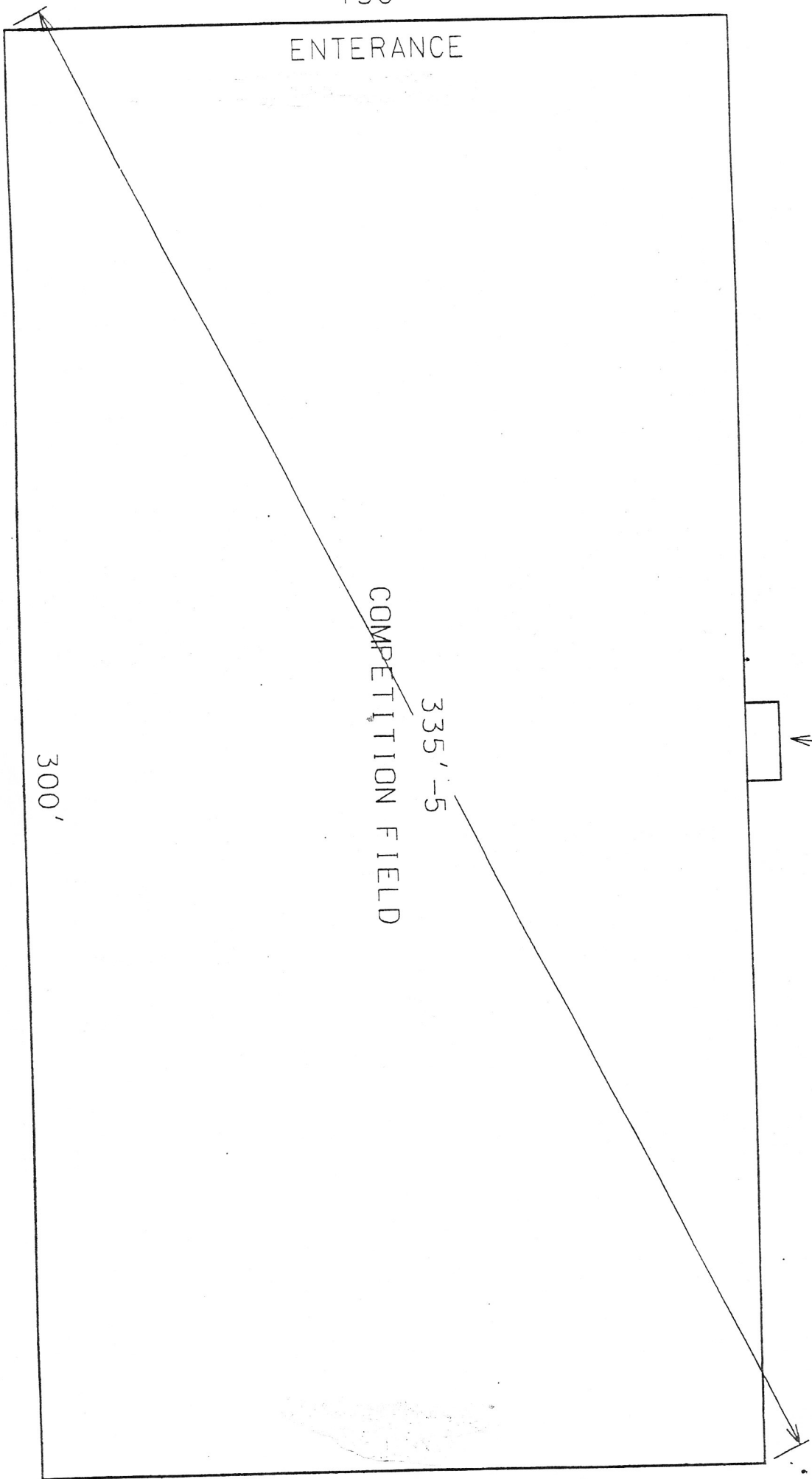


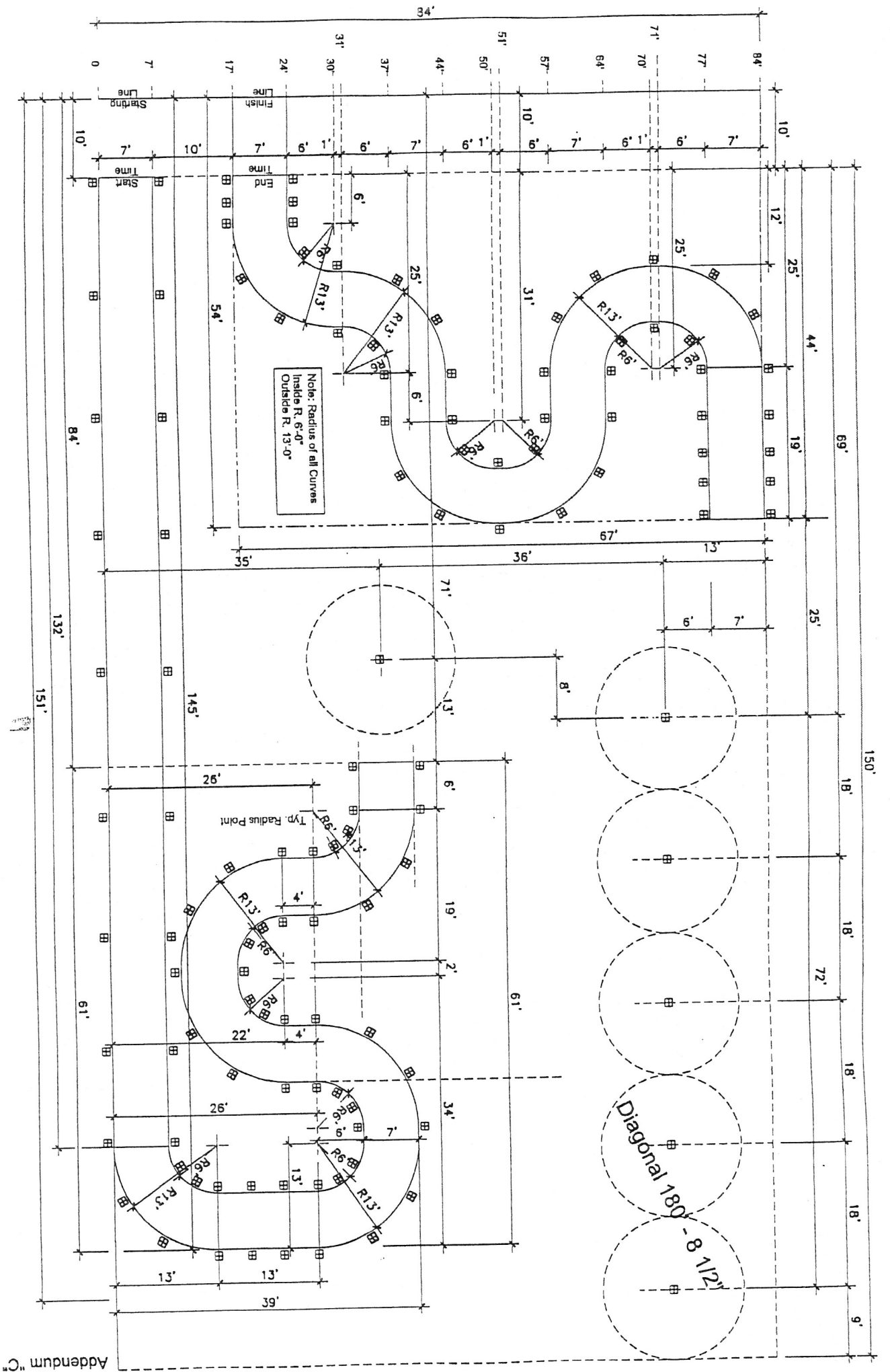

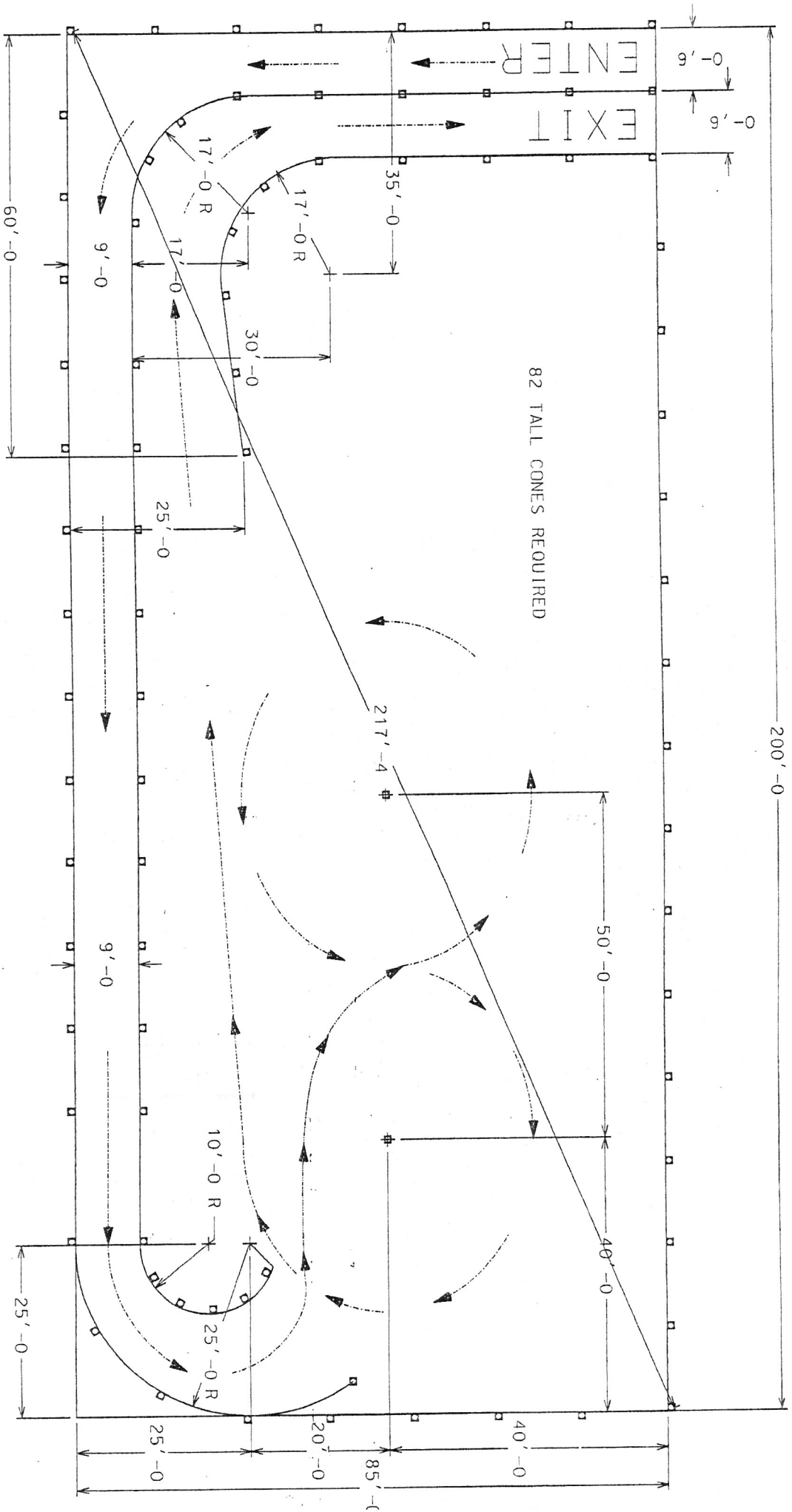




Obstacle Course

4 WHEEL OBSTACLE COURSE

INTERNATIONAL ASSOCIATION OF SHRINE MOTOR CORPS

SLOW RACE:

The object is to complete the course in the longest period of time.

RULES:

1. All riders from each two wheel unit can participate.
2. The combined time of the best two riders shall be the score for the unit.
3. The same motorcycle can not be ridden by two contestants.
4. Riders' foot/feet can not touch the ground. The time stops the moment the rider's foot touches the ground.
5. The cycle must proceed in a forward motion. Zig-zagging is allowed, but cycles must not run perpendicular to the direction of the course.
6. Riders must stay within the boundaries of the course. A rider going outside the course is disqualified.
7. The time also stops the moment a cycle falls over and touches the ground.
8. The time starts when the front wheel goes over the start line and time stops when the front wheel goes over the finish line.
9. All contestants and cycle must have participated in the personnel and equipment inspection.
10. Rider will enter course on the left and ride clockwise and exit on the right.
11. Each division of cycles will be competing within their own division for one trophy..
