CONFIRMATION OF YOUR ARRIVAL

Please check the attached calendar so you know when you are scheduled for arrival to your unit and week. We would like to suggest that you call the resort to verify your arrival, if we do not hear from you we will try to contact you via phone or email to confirm your arrival.

If you are unable to make your stay for this year, Marine Terrace offers many options for you:

- List your unit on our website for rent OR
- Sign a rental agreement with Marine Terrace and we will try to rent your unit for you. Marine Terrace only charges 15% if your unit rents and it gives you the peace of mind knowing that we are handling the rental of your unit.
- Take advantage of our In-House Exchange Program.
- Deposit your unit with Interval International www.IntervalInternationalWorld .com In doing this you will be able to take advantage of the many other properties that are offered around the world, however, a membership fee is required.

MAINTENANCE FEE PAYMENTS

Marine Terrace accepts prepayment checks with no additional fees. There is no minimum as to how much you send. Please make sure your UNIT/WEEK number is on your check. Also, owners may set up Bill Pay through their own personal bank and reference the account by unit and week. This is a great option for those that would like their maintenance fees paid before the holidays arrive.

If you would like to make your prepayment with a credit card by phone and/or online there is a 5% charge added. SORRY no partial payments accepted online, and we do not accept American Express.

2021 IN-HOUSE EXCHANGE PROGRAM

The resort has opened an opportunity for owners to exchange their scheduled week for a different date based on availability. The in-house exchange fee is \$49, and the policy requirements are as followed:

- Owners will have to choose their desired week when they call to make the exchange.
- Owners can only exchange their week 30 days prior to their unit/week arrival date.
- Owners must be current on their maintenance fees.
- Owners may only choose units that are of the same size as what they own and within the current year of deposit.
- Owners can choose to upgrade their unit to a larger sized unit, if one is available, for the difference in Maintenance fees plus tax.

A MESSAGE FROM MAINTENANCE AND HOUSEKEEPING STAFF

REPORT ISSUES-if you have any maintenance, housekeeping or inventory issues upon check in. We want to know about it so we can fix them ASAP.

CHECKING IN-Please be patient. The front desk staff will be happy to take your number and call you as soon as your unit becomes available there will be no check ins allowed before noon. Check in time is not <u>until 5:00 pm</u>. DO NOT go into your unit or ask staff members about the status of your room. If your room becomes available before 5:00 pm the front desk staff will be happy to check you in.

CHECKING OUT-Please follow the list of things to do before you leave so that you are not charged an additional \$50.00 cleaning fee. Do not check out with the front desk until everyone in your party has completely vacated the room.

STORAGE OF ITEMS-We are sorry, but we cannot hold items for you until your next visit.

FOOD LEFT IN THE UNIT-It is okay to leave food or items that are unopened. These items will get donated to the staff that cleans your room.

WE ARE A NON-SMOKING RESORT

Smoking seems to be a constant problem throughout the year. Marine Terrace is a non-smoking resort. No smoking is allowed on the property, except in the designated smoking areas. Please be respectful to those around you and smoke in these designated smoking areas only.

Smoking of any kind inside the units will not be tolerated and you will be assessed a \$250.00 cleaning fee for extra cleaning and possible charge if the next guest must be moved due to smoke.

NO PETS ALLOWED - Don't commit service-animal fraud

Pets are not permitted on our property with the exception of Registered Service Animals as governed by the American with Disabilities Act (ADA). Service animals must always be under the control of the owner. This means they cannot be left in the unit alone or unattended in any area of the resort. They must be on a leash with you when you leave your unit. Certified Emotional & Therapy Animals are not permitted, and do not fall under the regulations of the ADA. You will be reported and could face State charges as well as the Resort charging a \$250.00 cleaning fee. You may also be asked to leave or board your animal until your week is completed.

PARKING

Parking is limited! The resort offers <u>one</u> parking spot for each unit in the garage. However, the garage clearance is 6' 9", so in the event that your vehicle doesn't fit in the basement, you will need to park upfront. The twelve spots above ground will be subject to a first come, first serve basis. You cannot reserve or hold parking spots. All vehicles must be registered to avoid towing at owners expense. No trailers, boats, mobile homes, RV's or any of the like are allowed on the property.
