The Veteran Sweepstakes is open to all Boston Terriers (7) seven years of age and older on the day of the show. Entrants may be altered.

Professional Handlers are allowed to exhibit in the Puppy & Veteran Sweepstakes.

Indicate 'Sweepstakes' and the AGE DIVISION on the regular Entry Form under Additional Classes.

The winners of all classes in each Sweepstakes will compete for Best in Sweepstakes and Best of Opposite Sex in Sweepstakes.

Award of Merit

Following the Best of Breed Competition, the Specialty Breed Judge, at their discretion, may present Awards of Merit to up to 10 percent (10%) of the dogs competing for Best of Breed, including move-ups, Winners Dog, Winners Bitch, and the Veteran class winners. The percentage will be rounded up to get the full number that may be awarded, with a maximum of 3 AOM's.



Best in Puppy Classes: The first-place winners of each of the four puppy classes will compete for Best in Puppy Classes.

Best in Bred By Exhibitor Classes: The first-Place winners of each Bred By Exhibitor Class will compete for Best Bred By Exhibitor.

Best Veteran: The first-place winners of the veteran classes will compete for Best Veteran.

JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP

FREE

NOVICE JUNIOR CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years and under 12 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

NOVICE INTERMEDIATE CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 12 years and under 15 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

NOVICE SENIOR CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 15 years and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

OPEN JUNIOR CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years and under 12 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

OPEN INTERMEDIATE CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 12 years and under 15 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

OPEN SENIOR CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 15 years and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

MASTER CLASS: This class will be for Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years and under 18 years of age on the day of the show, and who have won the 10 First Place wins in an Open class, with competition, to be eligible to enter the AKC National Championship competition. The calendar for this class will be consistent with the eligibility dates for the AKC National Championship. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry on the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed, all participants return to the Open Class to compete for the following year.

COVID 19 BEST PRACTICES

after which time no entries may be accepted, canceled, changed, substituted, corrected, or signed and no entry fees refunded. All changes and cancellations must be received in writing prior to closing, except as provided for in Chapter 11, Section 6 of the AKC Dog Show Rules.

The Sonoran Desert Boston Terrier Club of Arizona, Inc., Tucson KC, Greater Sierra Vista KC, and their Show Secretary/Superintendent assume no responsibility for a wrong entry. Entries will not be accepted without proper fees and signatures. Entries must be submitted on approved entry forms with the agreement printed on the reverse side. Photocopies of front & back will be accepted if legible. Exhibitors are advised to print all unusual words when filling in entry forms.

THIS SHOW is governed by the American Kennel Club. Exhibitors should read the AKC agreement on the backside of the entry form in this Premium List.

No entry fee will be refunded for Bitches who come in season after the close of entries for this show, or for a dog that is absent, sick, lame, disqualified or excused by Veterinarian, Judge or Bench Show Committee. No entry fees will be returned if the show cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, strikes or any other causes beyond the control of the management. Extreme weather conditions, such as, but not limited to snow storms, hurricanes, lightning, extreme heat, must be considered for the health and safety of the dogs, exhibitors and spectators. The wellbeing of dogs, exhibitors and spectators is of paramount importance and, in the event it is necessary to cancel or stop the show before completion, no refund of entry fee will be made. **Note: Exhibitors** should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

RETURNED CHECKS will be charged a \$30.00 collection fee. The returned check and fee must be paid with Cash at the Show Secretary's desk or office **BEFORE** the dog will be allowed in the ring.

Dogs need not be at the show until the scheduled time of judging. Dogs no longer needed for further judging will be excused. This show is unbenched.

All dogs present must be held on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged or when in the exercising ring.

The Clubs, Pima County Fairgrounds, Show Secretary/Superintendent, their Agents, employees, etc. assume no responsibility for injury to children or pets not under the control of their parents, handlers, owners or guardians.

THIS IS A SELF-CLEANING SHOW. A Bench Show Committee will be called on anyone not cleaning up after their dog or their grooming space and a minimum of \$250.00 fine will be assessed.

Class cash prizes will be paid in the ring to the person showing the dog. Claims for prize money must be made in the ring before the judging is over, and the Show Secretary's office advised at once. The Show Secretary and show-giving Club disclaim any liability for cash prizes after the judging is over.

RECORDING & EVENT FEES include the 50¢ AKC Recording Fee and the \$3.00 AKC Event Service Fee on the first entry of a dog and a \$3.00 AKC Event Service Fee for each additional entry of the same dog in the regular and non-regular recordable single entry classes. There is no recording fee or event service fee for sweepstakes, futurities, brace/team, multi-dog classes, or special attractions. (AKC Rule, Ch 11, Sec 2).

TRANSFERS TO BEST OF BREED must be made at the Show Secretary's desk at least one-half hour prior to the start of the earliest conformation judging at each Show.
