## LD23 REGULAR MEETING (in person & Zoom) September 10 2020

#### I. Call to Order

Nancy Ordowski called the regular meeting to order at 7:00 pm. Alex Smith gave the invocation. Austin from the McSally campaign led the Pledge of Allegiance. II. Introductions

III. Speakers

Rich Rutkowski (2<sup>nd</sup> Vice-Chairman) Introduced **Lisa James** (follow: @no207AZ and <u>No207AZ.com</u>) to speak Against Prop 207 ("Smart & Safe Arizona Act"). Lisa informed the body that almost \$4 million have been contributed by the "Big Marijuana" industry to pass this prop, She explained brain damage in children from marijuana and that this prop would remove the only DUI test for THC. Lisa informed the body that today's marijuana contains 200 times as much THC then the marijuana that was smoked at wood stock (67 units of THC vs. 3). If 207 is passed **it will be almost impossible to overturn**.

Rich Rutkowski spoke against prop 208 which would add a 3.5 % surcharge to the current 4.5 % resulting in an 8% tax rate(Putting us at NY and CA tax rates), Rich also spoke against Maricopa county prop 449 which would continue a Property tax on home owners for 20 years to subsidize Maricopa county hospitals.

Nancy Ordowski (Chairman) introduced **Jim O'Connor**: Jim spoke of his run for Corp Comm as being called to service and the importance of voting for all the republican candidates running for Crop. Com and ALL OF THE REPUBLICANS ON THE TICKET.

Nancy Ordowski (Chairman) introduced **Tim Horn** who spoke about the Unity of the Party, the need to elect Martha McSally to the senate and voting the whole ticket. **We Need Every Vote!!**
