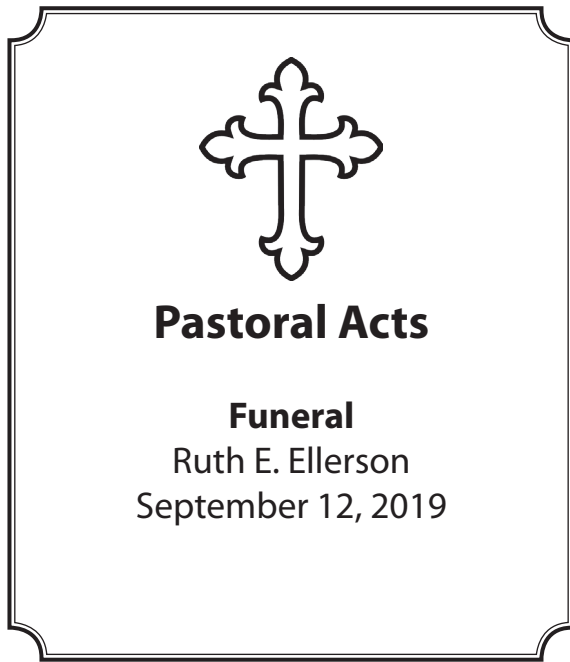
Most of the methods of communication we employ are Internet based. Besides the bulletin, *The Trumpet* is the only publication that people who don't use computers or are not able to be in church can receive Trinity information. It is also useful to give to visitors so they may learn about the activities and groups we have at Trinity.

You may have noticed that in the past several issues, we have added more in-depth articles that describe activities and events in depth. Last month we included some member profiles. We have received positive feedback from visitors and members alike.

Here is how production of *The Trumpet* should work. This depends on receiving your articles early in the month. ***We need your help to make it happen.***

1. **The due date for articles is the 5th of the month before the issue is printed. In other words, we should have most of the articles for the November issue by October 5.**
2. The Trumpet editor gathers the articles and edits them between the 5th and 10th of the month. (Janet Peterson sends out reminders early in the month).
3. Layout and proofing take place, between the 10th and the 20th.
4. Ideally, **The Trumpet** should be *mailed* by the 20th of the month in order to be received by the first of the month.

Entertainment Books (Fundraiser)

So far 11 Entertainment Books for 2020 have been sold yielding \$138 to help support the budget and outreach programs of Trinity. Although the Chicago North book sells for \$25, Entertainment Publications contributes 50% of the sales price back to Trinity. So in addition to helping you save money, purchasing an Entertainment Book also helps Trinity.

Trinity's original allotment of Entertainment Books for 2020 was 20 books. So we have long way to go to catch up with the 24 books sold last year. However, not included in the totals, are the orders being placed next week for out-of-town books for Milwaukee, Dayton and Orlando. So please either pick up your Chicago North EB or place your order for out-of-town EBs this Sunday.



Please make checks payable to Trinity Evangelical Lutheran Church and write Entertainment Book on the memo line. Enclose check with order form.

The Entertainment Book is great for:

- Travel almost anywhere, with big savings on restaurants, snack-shops, shopping, sporting activities, and services such as oil changes, dry cleaning, haircuts, etc.,
- Gifts for the holidays, birthdays or almost any occasion,
- Out-of-town family members and friends. Books can be ordered for most major cities, and shipped to their home address or delivered to Trinity. However, the price of out-of-town Entertainment Books varies by city with prices noted on a special order form at the Welcome Desk. The EB's can also be ordered online with Trinity still getting credit for the sale. More to follow on this.
- The Entertainment Books sell for \$25, which is a discount of \$10 off the regular price. Make your check payable to Trinity Evangelical Lutheran Church, and write "Entertainment Book" on the memo line.
- You don't have to wait until 2020 to start saving, because the Entertainment Card and the coupons can be used immediately. However, don't forget to use the coupons in your 2019 Entertainment Book first because most of them are good until the end of December.
- Again, we need to have everyone's help to make the 2020 Entertainment Book Fundraising Program a success.
