Try this...open your Bible or a pew Bible or any Bible you have access to randomly. Place your finger on the page. If you have been thinking about a problem or a person in need, it will amaze you that it has the answer. The problem is that trusting his wisdom is not always what you want to hear. God knows what's best; but we as humans want an instant resolution to the problem.

Mastering the Word of God doesn't come overnight. You must be in the Word. Devotionals, Bible study, Sunday School, etc. takes time. But when you grasp what God teaches, and read the outline that he wants you to do as a Christian, it changes attitude, awareness, and faith.
