

Everyday Pre-Drive Inspection

Follow these simple steps before driving every day to help ensure a safer trip.

1. Check the back seat, make sure no one is hiding there
2. Walk 360 degrees around the vehicle and verify your tires have no visible damage and adequate tread
3. Look for fluid on the ground that could indicate a leak
4. Once inside, check your visibility. Are the windows free of cracks/debris
5. Adjust your mirrors
6. Upon starting your car, check your gauges and watch for any warning lights
7. Before shifting into gear, have you secured everything that might shift during transit?
8. Buckle up! Seatbelts save lives, make sure you and all your passengers are wearing their safety belts.
