Please come down and enjoy your lodge.

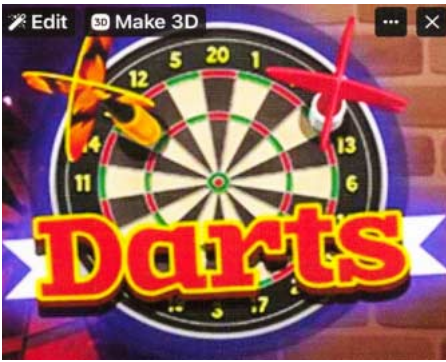
