Roy N. Wing, 96, of Pigeon, died Saturday, January 1, 2005, at his home following a brief illness. He was born November 23, 1908 in Pigeon, son of the late Daniel and Emma (Haist) Wing. He was married to Edna Bolzman, who preceded him in death. He then married Leota Weimer on November 7, 1975 in Caseville. She preceded him in death on April 21, 2003.
