

A&M-Bud Darts Rules For Playing In Extreme Leagues

- 1) Extreme leagues may not be played on the same nights that A&M-Bud Darts leagues are playing. Those nights are Sunday, Monday and Wednesday.
- 2) Players must be in good standing with A&M-Bud Darts leagues to play in Extreme leagues or online tournaments.
- 3) Players must be a current member of A&M-Bud Darts leagues when they sign-up and begin an Extreme league. To be considered a current member, a player must have played in at least half of his/her team's matches during the current season.
- 4) If you wish to play Extreme league but are not currently playing in one of the A&M-Bud Darts leagues, special permission may be granted to start an Extreme league if you plan to play in an A&M-Bud Darts league during the next season . However, if you start an Extreme league and then do not sign up for the next season of A&M-Bud Darts leagues, you will be removed from the Extreme league and be banned from playing any leagues for up to a year.
- 5) Players must check with A&M-Bud Darts league administration BEFORE entering a team in an Extreme league. A&M-Bud Darts reserves the right to cancel any team that was not approved before registration. Locations have the right to reserve dart machines in their establishments for purposes other than PPD events. Just because PPD shows a board and location as available, that may not always be the case.
- 6) Always check with the League Director and/or the location owner if you are going to try and play on multiple boards at the same time to ensure no conflicts.
- 7) Always check with the League Director and/or the location owner if you are planning to play an unscheduled make-up match.
- 8) Any current A&M-Bud Darts league member may sub for an Extreme team, if eligible. Players that do not currently play in an A&M-Bud Darts league may only sub once every 28 days for any team.

These rules take effect 11-16-2017. They apply to any Extreme league that begins after this date.
