High in Trial Awards will be calculated as follows:

Points for every Q will be as awarded (15 point Q will be 15 points, 10 point Q will be 10 points, 5 point Q will be 5 points). The level of HIT the dog will be competing in will be determined by the level the dog is entered in their first Regular class of the trial. For example: if a dog is entered in Open Regular on Saturday, no matter what levels (Novice, Open or Elite) the dog competes in for the other classes, (including EGC if offered), the dog will be considered an Open dog for HIT purposes. The last class on Sunday will not be included in the HIT calculation. If there is a tie after the second to last class, the tie breaker will be the dog with the most 1st place Qs (or 2nd place Qs if necessary). Each dog is eligible for HIT in one division only.

Volunteering:

Directions:

If you are traveling on I-90, take exit 434 at Laurel. Take Hwy 212/Hwy 310 towards Red Lodge. At Fort Rockvale stay on Hwy 212 towards Roberts/Red Lodge. Arena is on the west side of the highway at 7738 Hwy 212. It is easily visible from the highway. If you are traveling from Red Lodge on 212, turn west off the hwy to the arena.

Refund Policy:

If the Dept. of Transportation closes any interstate or secondary roads, all but \$4 entry for each run will be refunded. If someone withdraws from this trial before closing date, full refund will be given. In case of an injured dog or a bitch in heat, all but \$4 for each run will be refunded after the closing date.

NONJUMPING CLASSES – VETERAN OR DISABLED HANDLER

Handlers who are 60 years or older, or who have a disability that restricts mobility, may choose to enter the nonjumping classes as a Veteran Handler and receive 10% more standard course time. This option is for Veteran/Disabled handlers in the nonjumping classes only. The Veteran/Disabled Handler division is designed for handlers who, due to age or impairment, are mobility limited and need extra time to guide their canine partners through an agility course. When entering as a Veteran/Disabled Handler, you must enter all dogs in all classes for the entire trial in this Division and must jump 4" lower than your Proficient, Standard Division jump height requires. In the nonjumping classes, dogs will be scored and placed with their Standard Division jump height.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

Below is a brief summary of NADAC rules. Please refer to www.nadac.com for a full explanation of all NADAC rules and up to date information.

- Please note that NADAC trials should provide a safe and fun environment for both exhibitors and their dogs.
- Aggressive dogs will not be tolerated and will be excused from the trial.
- The show committee has the right to refuse any entry. Anyone not currently in good standing with NADAC will not be allowed to enter this trial.
- Exhibitors, through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of NADAC rules and regulations, and agree to abide by all rules in effect at the time of this trial.
- No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reasons of riots, civil disturbances, fire, acts of God, public emergency, an act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- Checks not honored by the bank do not constitute a valid entry fee. There be a \$25.00 service charge for bank returned checks.
- **Dog must be registered and have a valid registration number before entries will be accepted. <http://nadac.com/afirm/dogregfrm.asp>

THE MANAGEMENT will not be responsible for the loss or damage to any dog exhibited or for the possessions of any exhibitor, whether the result was by accident or any other cause. It is distinctly understood that every dog at this event is in the care, custody and control of his owner or handler during the entire time the dog is on the show premises. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Show Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of fees paid will be made.

NO AGGRESSIVE DOGS OR PEOPLE ARE ALLOWED. This trial is to have fun with your dogs and enjoy the sport of agility. PLEASE KEEP YOUR DOG ON A LEASH WHEN NOT IN THE RING. DOGS MAY NOT BE TIED TO A CRATE OR TREE OR ANYTHING UNDER ANY CIRCUMSTANCES. PLEASE CLEAN UP AFTER YOUR DOG IN ALL AREAS.

THIS IS A CONTAINERIZED TRIAL

FOOD/TOYS IN POCKET: Food or a small noiseless toy may be carried into the ring in your pocket provided it is contained in a ziplock bag or small container such as a pill bottle. The container cannot be visible in the ring nor within 10 feet of the ring. You cannot indicate to your dog that you have this item on you i.e. patting your pocket. You are not allowed to remove the container until you are at least 10 feet outside the ring. All food and toys must be contained at the trial and none can be left lying about loose. This policy has been implemented to reduce the possibility of dogs fighting over loose food or toys, diminish dogs dragging their handlers back to their crates (or wherever they left their food), and to lessen the amount of insects that are around loose food.

IMPORTANT: *Please check your dog's NADAC registration number on your trial confirmation as soon as you receive it; also, please check the copy of the results posted at the trial. You should report any errors to the Trial Secretary immediately.*

NADAC records trial results as they are submitted by the host clubs/groups. The individual trial results submitted by the club are uploaded to the www.NADACForum.com within two weeks after the NADAC office receives them from the club. Please accept the responsibility to review those results, and check that your registration number and qualifying points, as reported by the club, are correct. You can join the Forum by going to www.NADACForum.com and submitting your request. If you find an error in the reporting of your dog's qualifying points or registration number, please contact the host club. The host club is responsible for correcting any errors and informing NADAC.

Levels. Points earned at a higher level of a class, prior to the completion of the lower level title, will not be recorded by NADAC for future use. If a dog earns points in a level of a class that they are not eligible to title in, those points will not be added to the dog's records.

AGREEMENT

The person who signs this agreement represents that he/she is authorized to enter into this agreement on behalf of both exhibitor and the owner of entered dog. In consideration of acceptance of this entry:

- 1.1 As used here NADAC means North American Dog Agility Council, Inc., its members, officers, directors, employees, show chairs, show committees and agents.
- 1.2 Exhibitor/owner, agree to abide by the rules and regulations of NADAC and any other rules and regulations appearing in the premium for this event.
- 1.3 Exhibitor/owner certify that the entered dog is not a hazard to persons, dogs or property and that the entered dog's rabies vaccinations is current in accordance with the requirement of the state in which the dog resides.
- 1.4 Exhibitor/owner acknowledge all hazards presented by the event and the event premises, including but not limited to, the condition of the floors, stairways, halls, lighting, security measures or lack of, electrical appliances, fitting, show rings, parking areas and the presence of unfamiliar animals and people: exhibitor and owner assume the risk of any harm arising from these.
- 1.5 Exhibitor/owner release NADAC (including NADAC officers, directors, employees and members), Rocky Mountain Dog Stars (including officers, directors, employees and members) and Yellowstone Dog Sports (including officers, directors, employees and members) and will defend them and hold them harmless from all present and future loss, injury, damage, claims, demands and liabilities involving the entered dog, the event or event premises. Without limiting the generality of the foregoing hold harmless provisions, exhibitor/owner hereby specifically assume sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify and save aforementioned parties for damages because of bodily injuries, including death, at any time in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, howsoever such injury or death may be caused and whether or not the same may have been caused or may have been alleged to have been caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees or agents or any other persons.
- 1.6 Exhibitor understands there is a returned check fee of \$25.
- 1.7 Exhibitor understands that they are responsible for their and their dogs conduct at the show grounds during the entire weekend. Failure to comply can be a reason for dismissal from the trial; including no refund of monies and elimination of all scores obtained during the trial.
