Youth Classes: All youth must have an AMHA Youth number. Youth card applications are available at the Horse Show

Office. Youth membership fee is a one-time fee of \$10.00 or \$15.00 if applied for at show.

An AMHA Amateur Card is required to participate in Amateur classes. Amateur cards are **Amateur**

Liability Statement:

Southwestern Miniature Horse Club, its officers, officials and employees will not be responsible for any accident or loss which may occur to an exhibitor, spectator, guest, driver, groom, attendant or other employee, animal or equipment at this show. THIS SHALL BE A CONDITION OF ENTRY to this show or show grounds.

Show Policy:

Evidence of any cruelty, abuse or inhumane treatment to a horse, in or out of the ring, will not be tolerated by the Show Management and shall result in disqualification of the horse and that exhibitor for the balance of the show. The offender will be barred from the show area for the duration of the show. The results shall be the forfeiture of all trophies, ribbons, awards, and points for that show. The show manager will notify AMHA of any such disqualification when the show results are reported.

Pre-Entries:

Pre-Entries must be postmarked by April 17, 2021.

Added Classes: Added classes will be accepted up to four classes preceding the class to be entered.

Refunds:

The SWMHC will give a full refund if entries are cancelled in writing by the pre-entry closing date. If entries are cancelled in writing to the show manager and accompanied by a veterinarian's or doctor's certificate of inability to show after the pre-entry closing date, but before the official start of the show (8:00 a.m. Friday, April 30) all fees other than the stall and office fee will be refunded. After the official start of the show, there will be no refunds. Substitutions will be accepted without penalty.

Vendors:
