

Support for our Brothers and Sisters

Sanctuary is an ancient, religious custom of providing protection to those who seek safety out of fear. The site of sanctuary is a sacred space and helps provide for the stranger in need. Several faith communities in Minnesota are declaring their places of worship as places of sanctuary.

The Immigration Support Task Force at St. Cecilia's would like to have the parish community declare St. Cecilia's to be a "Sanctuary Supporting Church." This would link St. Cecilia's into an interfaith network of faith communities (church, synagogue or mosque) supporting immigrants through their public declarations of moral support, prayerful support and tangible help to "Sanctuary Churches." A public declaration of sanctuary supporting church is necessary to be included in the secure communication network that is required.

Being a sanctuary supporting church allows St. Cecilia's parishioners to have opportunities to support immigrants by:

- Continuing the support task force efforts to educate our community about the injustices and difficulties of the immigrants.
- Providing tangible, monetary and physical resources to sanctuary churches, such as food, money, clothing, toiletries, legal support, etc.
- Providing a welcoming presence in sanctuary churches if needed.
- Providing non-violent rapid response in situations of public need, such as documenting an ICE raid.
- Keeping abreast of legislation which affects immigrants and notifying parishioners of action steps needed.
- Keeping abreast of prayer vigils for immigrants.

All the actions listed above will be voluntary tasks of parishioners. Parishioners will have opportunities to become more involved as they desire.

Even if you choose to not become involved in Sanctuary work, we seek your prayers and moral support for those that do.

Please provide feedback on this proposal to the Parish Community Council team by Friday, April 21st. Feel free also to contact the Immigration Support Task Force Representative if you have questions regarding this proposal.

Hearing Devices

St. Cecilia's has several hearing devices available for use during Mass. If you would like to use one, they are located on top of the sound system cabinet by the piano, or ask one of the hospitality ministers for assistance.

Communion

Eucharistic Ministers are available to bring Communion to anyone not able to join the procession at Mass. Please tell one of the hospitality ministers before Mass if you need this service. After distributing to those in line, Communion will then be brought to you.

Sacramental Policies

Marriage: Six months notice is required. Three months active parish membership necessary prior to initiating marriage preparation. Call the parish office at 651.644.4502.
