you. One kit is Twinkling Stars and is a fabulous project using a great Christmas red and 4 different cream flannels. This quilt is approximately 92x92 and will be a great Christmas gift or great for your home.

Belle Isle by Minick and Simpson is in the shop and we've kitted their small version of Donwell Abbey using a blue background and cute little 4 patches but we added a striking inner and outer border to make the quilt a little larger without having to make more blocks. It finishes approximately 70x82. It's bright and cheerful with a side note of patriotic!



Our second quilt kitted is Old Saint Nick and it features flannels in grays and creams with trees and an old-world styled St. Nick. You could convert Santa to a snowman if you wanted to make your quilt useful for an extra season. It finishes approximately 64x80.
