**REPORTS:**

**North Region:** Will hold a retreat to plan for the future. They will also be revisiting accreditation.

**Funding:** Awards for Lummi Nation Community Contribution Grant won't be announced until April.

**Training officers:** EMT class at BTC start Feb 20<sup>th</sup>.

**CQI:** Next CQI meeting is March 29th at 5:30pm in the Health Education Center (HEC).

**TAB:** EMS manager Mike Hilley starts March 5<sup>th</sup>.

Contract for ImageTrend was signed by the county on February 13<sup>th</sup>.

ImageTrend is slow on the hospital end.

**Hospital:** Trauma Quality Assurance Committee presented a case where a femoral vein transected. It took 12 min to arrive on scene and then additional time to clear scene.

Trauma ACS service went into effect Feb 1<sup>st</sup>.

Any type of alert (trauma/stroke/STEMI) should not go to triage.

**New Business:**

Ben has created a SGA Roster, checklist and PowerPoint for the 4 hour SGA class.

Will need equipment and an SEI evaluator for every 5-6 students.

A time will be scheduled for the SEI's to get together for planning purposes.

A standard SEI fee of \$250 for four hours was suggested.  
Medics could sit thru class for no fee.

Ben will look into the requirement of a state application for each student and will send the PowerPoint to the education committee.

March/April are training months.

Duncan will calculate how many i-gels are needed and research bulk purchase options.

The committee will come up with a recommended date to switch to i-gels.

Protocol changes for i-gel and procedures need to be reviewed and finalized. They will be distributed to the Education committee for review

ASHI will be used for community education. The application to become an ASHI training center is being worked on.
