DeDe Duncan-Probe Is Bishop Elect for the Episcopal Diocese of CNY

I had the privilege to represent All Saints at the recent Special Convention of August 6 as a Delegate to Convention. As a member of the Search Team, whose work culminated in the creation of the final slate for this convention, I can share that any one of the candidates on the slate would be fit for our Diocese, and I hope the unsuccessful candidates all become a bishop in another Episcopal Diocese.

That aside, I am excited that Rev. Dr. Duncan-Probe will be our next Bishop. Present at this convention were about 150 Lay Delegates and 75 Clergy Delegates. Bishop Elect Duncan-Probe was elected on the second ballot by the majority of Lay Delegates and Clergy Delegates present.

Bishop Elect Duncan-Probe will be consecrated in December of this year, after the Standing Committees of every Episcopal diocese in the United States gives their consent. As this process for the Search Team began 13 months ago, it has been thoughtful and prayerful at every stage.

Please keep our diocesan leaders in your prayers through this continued period of transition.
