Becky Loyet addressed the Board concerning the issue of funding tutoring by the YMCA for students in Collinsville Township. She stated that Unit 10 schools offer this service at the present time. It was agreed to look further into the matter and report back on the issue.

Attorney Marc Parker did research on the issue and said townships can enter into agreements for social services. The Board agreed they would like to expand youth services.
