

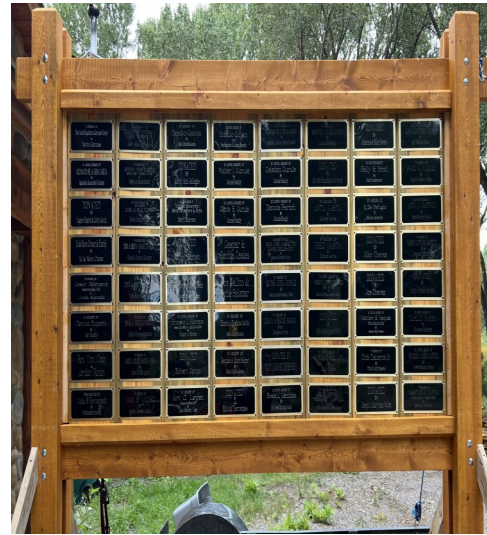


Our promise and dedication towards completing the Santuario in honor of Our Lady of Guadalupe and the Mysteries of the Rosary perseveres and each day brings us closer to its completion. The plaques will have a significant placement in the Santuario courtyard as you enter. This phase will begin in the spring of 2024.

This is a picture of the completed mission statue of St. Augustine that has been moved to its permanent home at the Sanuario along with the Holy Family statue. The process for the next mission statue will begin as entire donations are complete for each figure. We have volunteers actively seeking contributions for the remaining missions of Ortiz, San Rafael, Las Mesitas, San Miguel, and San Antonio. In addition to the mission statues surrounding the Santuario and the statue of Our Lady Of Guadalupe and St. Juan Diego at the entrance, walkways will lead visitors to various areas of interest. The placement of new trees will also be available to contributors who are interested in dedicating a tree in memory of a family member similar to what now exists on the New Veterans Boulevard entering the Village of Conejos. MASS THEME

**Theme: Do We Know Jesus Christ?**

We may be acquainted with persons for a long time, have social or business contacts, and yet not know them as they really are, for our contacts are superficial. Then at a certain moment there is a real encounter. Behind that casual smile, we discover entirely different persons. Meeting beautiful persons, having the privilege of being their friends, enriches our lives. How do you regard Jesus Christ? You have heard about him your whole life. You believe that he is alive, that he knows you, that he invites you to a person-to-person relationship. Yet you may know Jesus only superficially. John the Baptist said: "I did not know him." But the One [God] who sent him to baptize gave John insight, so that he could state: "Now I have seen [for myself]." Pray that God may help you to recognize the Lord Jesus, to see him as a beautiful person, a friend.

BIBLICAL COMMENTARY

**FIRST READING • Is 49:3, 5-6**  
**[God Is My Strength]**

This Bible reading is from the second "Servant Song" in Isaiah. (See commentary at last Sunday's Mass, "The Baptism of the Lord.") The prophet speaks of the Servant's prophetic mission, namely to raise up the tribes of Israel, who were downtrodden in Babylonian slavery. The Church reapplies this poem to Jesus Christ, God's Servant, whose mission it is to raise up you and me when we are depressed. That is what a friend does for a friend! The Responsorial Psalm is a prayer of thanksgiving for deliverance out of tribulation. The writer of the Letter to the Hebrews puts the words of the Refrain into the mouth of our suffering Savior. We should try to pray this psalm with our Lord.

**SECOND READING • 1 Cor 1:1-3**  
**[A Holy People]**

Paul sends his greetings to "the church of God that is in Corinth!" We are members of the universal Church, which is realized in our own congregation. We should not be narrow-minded and identify our own congregation with the universal Church. We are more than just members of "St. Jude's!"

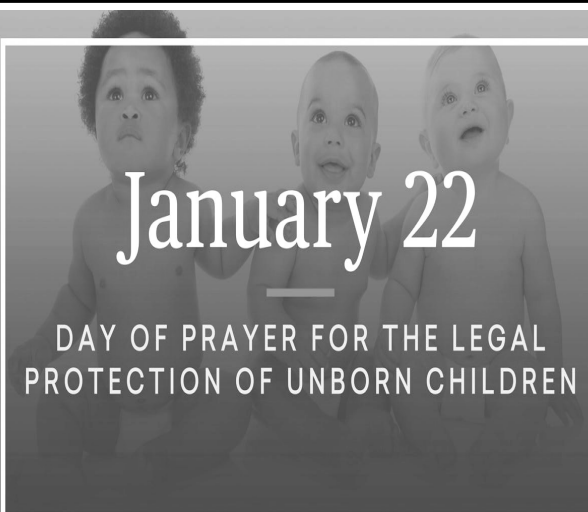
