

REGULAR MEETING
TOWN OF DELCAMBRE
July 08, 2019

Town of Delcambre regular session convened at 6:00 p.m. on JULY 08, 2019, at the City Hall, with Mayor Pro Tem Timothy Derise, presiding.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

MEMBERS PRESENT: Alderman Timothy Derise, Alderman Bryan Glatter, Alderman Donald Martin, Alderwoman Madison Saunier and Alderwoman Sarah Trahan.

MEMBERS ABSENT: Mayor Pam Blakely

ALSO, PRESENT: Town Clerk Shirley Wyles, Town Attorney Ted Ayo, Sellers & Associates Representative/Engineer Larry Cramer, Street Commissioner Homer Stelly, Shrimp Festival Association Representative, Tracey Trim, and 4 guests.

MOTION: Introduced by Alderman Bryan Glatter and seconded by Alderwoman Madison Saunier "moved to accept and dispense the minutes of the regular meeting of June 17, 2019 as reviewed." Motion Carried:

DISCUSSION: Street Commissioner Homer Stelly, reports the Water Meter construction is going as schedule with no major complications found. Installation of 218 meters installed as of date. Sellers & Associates representative Larry Cramer informed the members of Council of project estimation of completion as of date is at 40% contract time and 50% overall. Mr. Cramer request a change order which will adjust the contract to include a line locator.

MOTION: Introduced by Alderman Donald Martin and seconded by Alderman Bryan Glatter "moved to approve change order as requested by Engineer, Larry Cramer.

MOTION: Introduced by Alderman Bryan Glatter and seconded by Alderwoman Madison Saunier "moved to approve reconditioning of Fire Department roof as quoted by Witten Construction with contractor being responsible for removing all debris and cleanup". Motion Carried.

MOTION: Introduced by Alderwoman Sarah Trahan and seconded by Alderman Bryan Glatter "moved to approve City Hall/Police Department roof repair as quoted by Pelican Roofing with contractor being responsible for removing all debris and cleanup". Motion Carried.

MOTION: Introduced by Alderwoman Madison Saunier and seconded by Alderwoman Sarah Trahan "moved to approve reappoint Tammy Gordon to the Vermilion Economic Development Alliance "V.E.D.A." board serving a four (4) year term". Motion Carried.

DISCUSSION: Casey St. Marie, owner of Chill Zone, request permission from the Town of Delcambre for the sale of alcohol. It was determined the current location of business is less than the state allowed distance of a school zone/property line. State allowed distance must no less than 300'. With the current location of the Chill Zone being at 182' from Delcambre High School, permission has been denied.

- MOTION: Sophia Vidalier request permission on behalf of her Mother, Gena Darby, Manager of Bayou Billiards Sports Bar, for extended hours of operation during the Shrimp Festival weekend dates of August 16th and August 17th. Request Died for lack of motion
- MOTION: Introduced by Alderman Bryan Glatter and seconded by Alderwoman Madison Saunier "moved to extend the agenda for discussions and approvals for Delcambre Police Department Shrimp Festival Association." Motion Carried.
- MOTION: Introduced by Alderman Bryan Glatter and seconded by Alderwoman Madison Saunier "moved to approve the purchase of a new motor for the Police Department's 2013 Ford Explorer Interceptor pending funds and verification of compatibility with the Police Interceptor vehicle.
- MOTION: Introduced by Alderwoman Sarah Trahan and seconded by Alderman Bryan Glatter "moved to approve and issue permission statements for the sale of Alcohol to the Shrimp Festival Association for the event of "Delcambre Shrimp Festival" scheduled for August 14, 2019 thru August 18, 2019". Motion Carried.
- DISCUSSION: Delcambre Fire Chief, Brock Benoit, informed the Council of the department's upcoming conference on August 7th thru August 10th. Iberia Parish will be responsible for covering the Town during this time.
- DISCUSSION: Street Commissioner, Homer Stelly, addressed the members of Council in reference to the pump being out at lift station # 10 located at the old sewage plant on Wilfred Landry Street. As of date, a rental has been in place for a week.
- MOTION: Introduced by Alderwoman Sarah Trahan and seconded by Alderman Donald Martin "Moved to Adjourn." Motion Carried.
