Items of Special Interest to Our Members

- ♦ The Rotary International Conference will take place June 23-27 in Toronto, Canada. The location of the Conference rotates among the major cities around the world - it is rare indeed for the conference to be held so close to us.
- ♦ The Club is submitting an application for a District Local Grant for 2018-2019 to construct an access ramp to the second floor and deck of the Watermen's Museum Carriage House. York County and the Watermen's Museum will contribute to the cost of the project. If our application is accepted, the Watermen's Museum will contract with a builder for the materials and labor where required. Club member Scott Chandler will lead the project and Club members will contribute approximately 320 hours of sweat equity in the October-November time frame.
