One Team, One Mission.


- Intergovernmental Support Agreements (IGSAs)
 - Authority resides in 10 U.S.C § 2679
- The Service Secretaries can enter into IGSAs with <u>State and local governments</u> to provide, receive or share installation support services
 - Entity must already provide the service for its own use
 - Ability to sole-source
 - Not exceed a total 10-Year Life Cycle Cost of \$15 M
- The Secretary must determine that an IGSA will:
 - Serve the best interests of the Air Force
 - Enhance mission effectiveness, or create efficiencies or economies of scale, including by reducing costs
- SAF/IEI has delegated the best interest determination authority to Installation Commanders
- IGSA is one tool in the toolbox -> Ideal when military saves money and community benefits

- Contracting customers benefit from IGSA
 - Dollars saved and "Best Value"
 - Dollars validated in AQC Cost Saving Tracker
 - Time saved Process time from 120+ days to 30 days
- IGSAs became another tool next to FAR-base acq
 - Grows "Mission Focused Business Leaders"
 - Opportunities across the BOS portfolio
- Working agreements takes time and energy
 - Meetings with municipal officials
 - Better to do few well than many poorly
 - Process fatigue is real
 - 502 CONS works approximately 4 per year

JBSA Pavement IGSA



■ One Team, One Mission.

- Partnership Need/Requirement
 - Improved support and cost savings for pavement projects and road work
- Partnership Description
 - Joint Base San Antonio (JBSA) and the City of San Antonio signed an Intergovernmental Support Agreement (IGSA) for pavement and road work improvement



How the Partnership Works

- JBSA will be able to request the completion of pavement projects costing up to \$15 million over a 10 year period from the City of San Antonio
- The contract covers a five-year ordering period with a five-year option period.
 JBSA will issue task orders as required for paving projects to the City to rehabilitate JBSA's roads. The agreement covers mill and overlays, roadway stripping, tack coat, and traffic control plans

Partnership Benefits

 Estimated overall cost savings of 25% with a reduced award time frame (30 vs. 150 days)

JBSA Blanket IGSA



One Team, One Mission.

- JBSA is pursuing the Air Force's first blanket IGSA for services with the Alamo Area Council of Governments (AACOG)
- This agreement will be broad, offering the greatest flexibility to the AACOG, which is comprised of many cities, counties and other organizations
 - Allows for an expedited IGSA/award process for goods and services to the installation such as bulk purchases, water well maintenance, fire suppression maintenance, elevator maintenance, etc.

Directions for AFCP SharePoint Account

How to Register:

The process of establishing an account consists of two steps:

- 1. Create an APAN account:
 - To register for an account, go to <u>https://wss.apan.org/s/airforcepartnerships</u>
 - In the upper right hand corner of the site, click the green "Create an Account" button
 - Enter your e-mail address as requested
 - A validation e-mail will be sent to you from APAN Support. Follow the instructions provided in the e-mail to set up your account



Hosted on All Partners Access Network (APAN), a web-based, non .mil collaboration platform developed to foster information and knowledge sharing between DOD and non-DOD entities

- 2. Register on the site as a user:
 - After you have set up your account, log back into APAN(https://apan.org/). Cut and paste the link into your browser (https://wss.apan.org/s/airforcepartnerships) and hit Enter to go to the SharePoint site
 - Register under First Time Users on the main page to be added as a user. Until you request access, you will only have limited access to content on the Welcome page. You will receive access within one business day
