Is there a special education program at Paulden Community Charter School?

- Yes, our Special Education Director, from Canyon State Educational Solutions, conducts and oversees all Individual Education Programs (IEPs).
- IEPs are differentiated and delivered in an appropriate learning environment.
- Our Speech Pathologist and her assistant provide services to qualifying students.

Is Paulden Community Charter School fully staffed?

- Yes, we are fully staffed and several of our staff our bilingual.
 - o One full-time paraprofessional
 - o A full maintenance staff
 - o Two bus drivers and one substitute
 - o A full-time Physical Education/Health & Music Instructor
 - o A full-time cook

Is there breakfast, hot-lunch, and transportation for the students?

- Breakfast and hot-lunch are available at no-cost for all students and meet the federal and state guidelines.
- Paulden has two bus routes that include the Chino Valley and Paulden area.
