We will be holding sound healing ceremonies and shamanic journeys to remember and connect with the old ones. From this grounded location, where we will be blessed with beautiful vegetarian meals, we will travel to the surrounding sacred sites and call upon the deep secrets of the lands to return to our spirits and enliven us.

Once we have rewoven ourselves within the sweet earth of the Isle, we will join Anthony Murphy, a local Irish journalist, photographer, author and astronomer, at the gateway to Ireland's historic Boyne Valley. Anthony has spent almost 20 years researching, photographing and writing about the ancient megalithic monuments of the Boyne Valley and their associated mythology, cosmology and alignments. In the summer drought of 2018, Anthony and his friend Ken Williams flew their drone over the valley to discover evidence of henges never seen before, only a stone's throw from the famous Newgrange site. Together, we will step lightly on the hills and stones of the Old Ones, on and off the beaten path of The Ancient East. We will walk through rich stories and wonders of the Neolithic tribes, ancient astronomers and their creations, their monuments to the dead and alignments to the stars.

On our sweet journey, we will walk the balance of the Sacred and the Mundane. We will speak, sing and meditate with the Ancestors and the Goddesses and Gods of the land. We will listen with our hearts what the wind, the smell of the wet soil, the soothing nature all have to say. We will celebrate our own ancient selves, arising today and activate our hearts with our own sacred wisdom.
