Bill called the meeting to order at 4:00 pm.

Ed made a motion to approve the Minutes of May 29, 2018 as amended. Second by John. All in favor.

Marj Erickson said that the next planned Unity Community Event will be a campfire, moon gazing outing on the Town Common with a raised fire pit. They spoke with the Fire Department who suggested getting a letter of approval from the Selectmen then having approval from the Fire Warden. The event will take place on June 22nd with a rain date of the 23rd. Consensus of the Selectmen to approve the event on the Town Common and write letter to the Fire Department.

John made a motion to approve and sign a vacation request for Joe Bonaccorsi for July 30 and Aug 20, 2018. Second by Bill. All in favor.

Ed stated that he had a call from the DES regarding an inspection that they need to do on a complaint on Fisher Road. The DES asked if any of the Selectmen would like to attend at 11:00 am. Ed will go and possibly Bill.

At 4:50 Ed made a motion to go into non-public session under RSA 91-A for Personnel. Second by John.

At 5:15 Ed made a motion to go back into the Selectmen's meeting. Second by John. All in favor.

Craig Allen discussed the issues with the 2017 Western Star truck and said that he believes that it is related to the shift pattern on the Alison transmission, which he is working on. He said he has not been ignoring the town and the truck is not broken. John stated that the Town will not buy another truck from Patriot Trucks if they can't get this one fixed. Ed said that the Town has yet to hear back on the failed tires on the truck either. Also, the loaner trucks came to the Town without plates and were unusable. Craig said to file a complaint directly with Daimler Trucks. He will e-mail Tracy all the contact information tomorrow. Also, Michelin was supposed to mail a refund check for the tires. He will look into that.

Paul Moeller said that he did an inspection on the Andrasi property, which still needs an electrician.

Ed made a motion to have the Chairman sign a stop-payment authorization for a lost check to Gatekeeper Lock & Key back in January. Second by John. All in favor.

Bill made a motion to sign a 90 day Camper/Parking Permit for Travis Conley on Britton Road while he continues to build his house. Second by John. All in favor.

At 7:15 pm John made a motion to adjourn. Second by Ed. All in favor.
