CARAVAN TOWING TERMS and what they all mean

Tare mass (vehicle)




The mass of the tow vehicle, as specified by the manufacturer, with no payload.

Payload (vehicle)




Any mass you add to the tow vehicle's tare mass, including passengers, luggage, aftermarket bull bars and tow ball mass.

Tare mass (caravan)




The mass of the caravan, as specified by the manufacturer, with no payload.

Payload (caravan)



Any mass you add to the caravan's tare mass, including luggage, food, accessories and non-standard equipment. It does not include people within the caravan when stationary.

Tow ball mass
The mass exerted on the tow ball by your fully packed caravan.



ATM (aggregate trailer mass)

The tare mass of your caravan, plus its maximum payload, plus tow ball mass.


GVM (gross vehicle mass)

The tare mass of your vehicle plus its maximum allowable payload. GVM also includes tow ball mass when the car is hitched to a caravan.

GTM (gross trailer mass)

The maximum allowable mass placed over the caravan's axle while the caravan is hitched. It includes the maximum allowable payload but does not include the tow ball mass.
