



**STATE OF NEW JERSEY DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION – RE: HAMPTON TOWNSHIP’S APPLICATION FOR A GRANT TO FUND SECTION III OF THE KEMAH MECCA LAKE PAVING PROJECT**

The Township Committee reviewed and accepted correspondence from the New Jersey Department of Transportation stating that the NJDOT is unable to provide FY 2016 Municipal Aid Grant funds for the Kemah-Mecca Lake Road-Section III Project.

Township Administrator E. Klose confirmed that the Township Budget will not be impacted due to the lack of NJDOT funding. She recommended waiting to do the work on Kemah Mecca Lake Road Section III until grant funding becomes available in the future.

**DISCUSSION**

**RECREATION PARK WALKING PATH**

Township Committeeman T. Dooley stated that he met with the Hampton Township Board of Education to discuss the Recreation Walking Path planned for the Hampton Township Municipal Park because one section belongs to the McKeown Elementary School. The Board of Education agreed to allow the township to use a portion of the school property to construct the walkway.

**A MOTION** was made by Committeeman T. Dooley and seconded by Committeeman D. Hansen, with all members in favor, to move forward with an Interlocal Shared Services Agreement with Hardyston Township for Paving/Construction Services, subject to Township Attorney S. Roseman's review and the adoption a Hampton Board of Education Resolution granting permission to Hampton Township to construct a portion of the new Recreation Walking Path on school property.

#### **ROLLING ACRES DRIVE AND PLOTTS ROAD**

Township officials listened to concerns expressed by Mr. McDole and Mr. & Mrs. Machacek, residents living on Rolling Acres Drive, regarding a drainage problem that causes excess rainwater to flow from Rolling Acres Drive to Plotts Road. During the winter months, the water freezes and creates dangerous road conditions. The residents sited certain safety issues, including the fact the area involved is located at a school bus stop.

Township Administrator E. Klose explained that this issue was first raised at the March 29, 2016 Township Committee Meeting. As a result, Administrator E. Klose contacted DPW Manager D. Bayles and asked him to inspect the site and provide feedback regarding a possible solution. One option discussed was to make improvements to one of the drainage swales on the roadway.

Mayor P. Yetter suggested that Committeeman T. Dooley meet with the parties involved on Rolling Acres Drive to inspect the area. If necessary, Mayor P. Yetter stated Township Engineer H. Pellow could provide recommendations to the Township Committee.

#### **DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS REQUEST TO USE A UNIFORM SERVICE**

**A MOTION** was made by Committeeman K. Hansen and seconded by Committeeman K. Gourlay, with all members in favor, to contract with Dempsy Uniforms for the purpose of providing commercial laundry services for the Township Department of Public Works uniforms for an annual fee of \$3,000.00.

#### **RECEIPT OF HAVA GRANT BIDS TO MAKE ADA UPGRADES TO THE HAMPTON TOWNSHIP COMMUNITY AND SENIOR CENTER**

**A MOTION** was made by Committeeman D. Hansen and seconded by Committeeman K. Gourlay, with all members in favor, to accept a bid from Tony's Concrete of Newark, NJ for \$47,890.00 to make ADA upgrades to the Hampton Township Community and Senior Center and to fund the project using a \$33,307.42 HAVA Grant and \$14,582.58 from the Hampton Township Budget.

#### **TOWNSHIP DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS TRUCK BID**

**A MOTION** was made by Committeeman D. Hansen and seconded by Committeeman T. Dooley, with all members in favor, for Township Administrator E. Klose and Township Attorney S. Roseman to prepare a bid package for the above referenced equipment.

#### **HAMPTON TOWNSHIP FIRE AND RESCUE UPDATE**

HTVFR Chief D. Gunderman reported that HTVFR responded to 41 EMS calls and 10 fire calls in the month of April.

**PUBLIC SESSION**

Kittatinny Little League (KLL) Treasurer R. Kowalski requested permission for KLL to utilize the Concession Stand located in the Hampton Township Pavilion for special events, e.g., Opening Day, Closing Ceremonies, Championships and Hampton Day. The Township Committee agreed by full consensus to consider the matter further providing KLL submits a proposal detailing how the organization intends to operate the Stand.

In the event that KLL decided not to operate the Pavilion Concession Stand on Hampton Day, Committeeman D. Hansen noted that Hampton Township Fire & Rescue, Inc. would be happy to operate it for the day.

Mr. Kowalski also requested permission for KLL to sell pre-packaged nachos in the Township Snack Shack located next to the Township Baseball Field. The preference would be to sell warm nachos using canned cheese that is heated using an electric heating element specially designed for the product. All of the nachos components are self-contained and do not require any type of cooking or cleanup.

**A MOTION** was made by Committeeman T. Dooley and seconded by Committeeman S. MacKenzie, with all members in favor, to permit KLL to sell pre-package nachos at the Township Snack Shack on a one-month trial basis and to reconsider the matter at the May 31, 2016.

The Township Committee reiterated that it is essential for KLL to submit their requests in the months leading up to opening season in order to provide adequate time for them to consider the issues pertaining to their requests. Committeeman D. Hansen stated that without proper notice, it is sometimes difficult for the Township Committee to accommodate KLL's requests, thus creating a public perception that the Township Committee is not supportive of their endeavors, which has never been the case.

Township Recreation Member B. Crawn requested permission from the Township Committee to hold a 5K Race on the Township Municipal Complex grounds on Hampton Day, June 4, 2016.

**A MOTION** was made by Committeeman T. Dooley and seconded by Committeeman S. MacKenzie, with all members in favor, to permit Blaine Crawn to conduct a 5K Race on the Township Municipal Complex grounds on June 4, 2016.




