## ANTI-SEX TRAFFICKING REPORT

Through websites such as Backpage.com, the internet has long since overtaken the street corner as the marketplace for buying and selling sex and therefore for sex trafficking. Until recently ads were placed on Backpage.com for selling young teens, Now the website must scrutinize for anything illegal. Prostitutes previously were treated as criminals and now by law they are to be treated as victims. In November, the Senate Commerce Committee unanimously passed the Stop Enabling Sex Traffickers Act (SESTA) through to a full Senate vote. SESTA is a narrowly focused, bipartisan bill that targets websites that knowingly facilitate sex trafficking. It ensures websites that violate federal sex trafficking laws are held accountable, without inadvertently affecting good actors that aren't deliberately enabling sex trafficking.

Every day there are more and more newspaper articles and TV programs on Anti-Sex Trafficking. Progress is slow, but with efforts by organizations such as NCJW we are making headway. Raise your own awareness by reading articles relating to Human Trafficking.

We are looking for more opportunities to utilize our NCJW Speaker's Bureau in Palm Beach and Broward counties. We have recently received additional training and we are ready to go!!

### Computer Printing Tip:


Have you ever wanted to print out only one page of a bulletin? Here's how it works on a PC:

At the top of the screen, do not click on the printer picture. Instead click on the word FILE, then click on PRINT.

After the PRINT box shows, select from the Pages To Print options.

ALL = prints every page in the document

CURRENT PAGE = prints only the page that the cursor is on


