Norway Cruise in July of 2018

Signups have begun for our ski trip to Breckenridge. To date we have 23 people ready to make the trip. This year we have 2 new members going with us. They are friends of Nina Dunn. She has quite a group going with her.

IMPORTANT: for those who plan on skiing more than 5 days, you might want to look at buying an Epic Pass. Check the pricing on <u>www.snow.com</u>.

Prices are per person -Lodging: 2 bedroom/2 bath condo is \$697.07 Hotel room is \$637.00 breakfast will be added automatically for hotel rooms. Lifts: 5 Day Senior pass \$520.77 Breakfast: Spencer's Breakfast Buffet \$112.00 Beaver Run has condos as well as Hotel Rooms which are located on the slope at Peak 9 in Breckenridge and is a short walk to town or a shuttle runs continually. We will go Saturday to Saturday since there is no difference in pricing for the rooms or airfare. We will fly into Denver and Transportation will be provided from Denver to Breckenridge.

Rooms

Make yourself at home in one of the 535 guestrooms featuring microwaves and iPod docking stations. Flat-screen televisions with cable programming provide entertainment, while complimentary wireless Internet access keeps you connected. Private bathrooms with bathtubs or showers feature complimentary toiletries and hair dryers. Conveniences include complimentary newspapers and coffee/tea makers, and housekeeping is provided daily.

Amenities

2019 Ski Trip to Chile - August 2nd-9th



I have received information on the trip to Chile for 2019. The pricing below is at Puerto del Sol Hotel. Reservations must be made by December 31st 2018 and paid in full to receive the following discounted pricing. I will be getting additional information for this trip in September. I cannot arrange for flights until then.

1 double north room per 2 people per 7 nights usd \$4064 (price include 25% discount) or \$2034 per person. 1 double south room per 2 people per 7 nights usd \$3770 (price include 25% discount) or \$1885 per person.

To book, a 30% deposit is required with the final payment due December 31st, 2018.

Our rates do not include the 19% Value Added Tax (known as IVA); however, guests who are not residents of Chile do not pay IVA if they settle their room bill in dollars or with a dollar credit card.

All foreign visitors without Chilean residence must present their international tourist card when checking in.

- . Quote subject to availability and rate valid for 7 days after quote has been sent.
- . Children 0 to 4 years of age stay free if they share a room (bed) with their parents.
- . Pets are not allowed. Smoking is prohibited inside Hotels.

Check-In: 4pm. If the room (or apartment) is available earlier, guests may check in before this time, if not, they may leave your luggage at the front desk and enjoy the mountain until the room is provided at the official time.

Check-Out: 10am. Guests who check out after 10am, will be charged a Late Check-Out fee to the room bill equivalent to one night's stay (rack rate).

Check-In: 4pm. If the room (or apartment) is available earlier, guests may check in before this time, if not, they may leave your luggage at the front desk and enjoy the mountain until the room is provided at the official time.

*Two free interconnect tickets to neighboring ski areas per person (one for La Parva and one for El Colorado), valid, for reservations of 7 nights or more.

*Welcome Drink only Saturday.

*Access to outdoor heated pool, Children's daycare (3 to 7 years), Game Room, Pub, Planned activities.

*Access to Fitness Center.

*For guests at the Puerta del Sol and Valle Nevado hotels only: One full-body massage per person (basic treatment, 25 minutes), valid for reservations of 7 nights or more. This service is non-transferable, and subject to availability. Only for guests ages 11 and up. Massages available from 10am to 4pm. Reservations must be made before 10am. *Wi-Fi in public areas.

Rates Do Not Include:

*Transfers, drinks and alcoholic beverages, Room Service, Laundry, Medical Clinic, Sauna or massages, Cyber Café, Telephone, Fax, Snow School, Internet Connection, Minibar. *Corkage fee for liqueurs and wine in restaurants, bars and common areas.

There is an onboard credit for those who have 200 shares of Carnival stock. The credit is available for all of the Holland America cruises. The number of travel days determines the size of the credit.
