


One day, I was complaining to God. I whined about how I don't see the displays of God's power and presence today, like I read about in the Gospels. I was complaining that for years I have been praying for revival in America...and still only see churches decline and close. I was feeling discouraged and frustrated. I cried out to God, "Why won't you send a wave of revival across our land?" And that's when a vision of that wave came into my head. Now, I don't know for sure whether it was from God or just my own head, but here is what I saw. I saw how the ocean water recedes just before a big wave comes crashing over the shoreline. The thought that came to mind was..."It's coming!" What we are experiencing now is the receding waters just before the next great wave.

Then, I remembered that many times throughout the Bible that the people of God were in those receding waters. Think of the Israelites when enslaved by Egypt, or exiled in Babylonia. There have been many times that God's people cried out for revival of some form or another. And it often took many years before those prayers were answered. God's wisdom is always perfect. And so is his timing. We are living in a time of receding waters...but that is good news because the wave is coming. So, if you feel discontent with the church's influence in the world...be patient. Instead of looking at your feet and watching the water recede. Look at the horizon...and watch for the next wave...because it's coming. The wave of revival is coming.




