Dogs in the Park

Dogs are allowed in the park as long as they are leashed at all times.

Dogs will NOT be allowed in the beach area. Beach area is defined as the sandy area, separated from the mulch with the divider between them. This area is between the parking lot and the water - signs are posted!

Dogs are also NOT allowed in the playground area which is defined as the area encased with concrete sidewalk. Sidewalk shall be considered part of the playground – signs are posted. (Ord 4-5-1(b)(3))

Blowing/mowing grass into the street

Per ordinance 9-3-2 (c) no person shall deposit any refuse, leaves or grass clippings in any gutter along any public street, road, alley or highway. Please protect our storm sewers and sweep up if you must blow into the street.

PARKING ON GRASS

Per Village Ordinance 10-1-65, all vehicles parked in a front yard must be on a driveway or hard surface; parking on front lawns is not allowed. Please be conscientious in your neighborhoods!

Regulation of Length of Lawn and Grasses Village Ord. 6-1-8

Lawns, grasses and noxious weeds on lots or parcels of land which exceed eight (8) inches in length adversely affects the public health and safety of the public in that they tend to emit pollen, and constitute a fire hazard and a safety hazard in that debris can be hidden in the grass. For that reason, any lawn, grass or weed on a parcel of land which exceeds eight (8) inches in length is hereby declared to be a public nuisance. ****In any case where the owner or occupant fails to cut the lawn, grass or weeds, the Village may elect to cut the lawn, grass or weeds and shall charge the expense of doing so to the property owner.**

Notice of Water/Sewer Rate Increase

Water customers of the Pardeeville Municipal Water Utility. This is to give you notice that the Pardeeville Municipal Water Utility will file an application on June 20, 2019, with the Public Service Commission of Wisconsin (PSC), for authority to increase water rates. Rates for general service will increase 3.0 percent. The increase is necessary to reduce the existing deficiency in present rates. The request is being made under Wis. Stat. 196.193. Rate increases granted under this statute do not require a public hearing. The effect of the increase for some selected customers is shown below. Public Fire Protection and Wholesale rates (if applicable) will also increase 3.0 percent. This rate increase will go into effect on September 9, 2019.

In addition there will be a 4.0 percent increase in the sewer charges effective September 9, 2019. If you have any questions about the rate increase request, call the Pardeeville Utilities at (608) 429-3121.

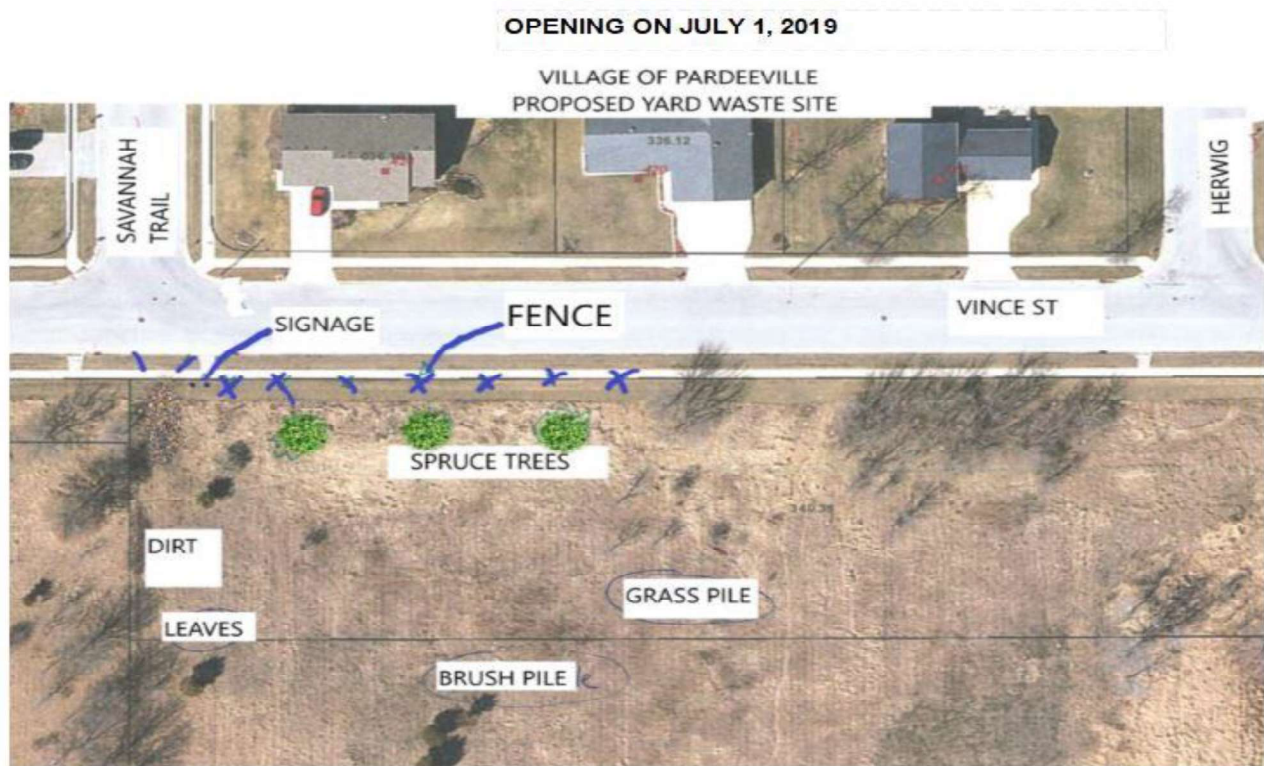
